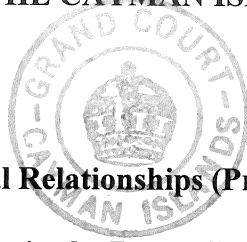

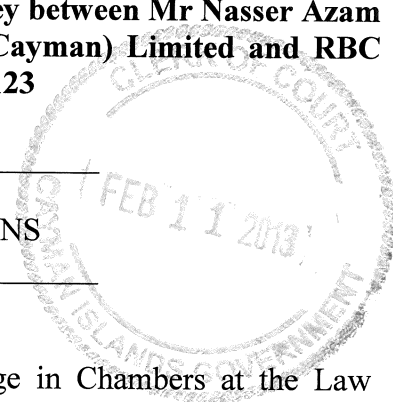

who are required by Order of the Royal Court of Jersey dated 5th September 2012 to disclose confidential information, for direction pursuant to Section 4 of the above-mentioned Law.

The Applicant is required by the Order dated 5th September 2012 to give in evidence confidential information belonging to Merrill Lynch Europe Limited by means of discovery of documents, evidence in writing by one or more witness statements and/or oral evidence in examination in chief and/or cross examination and seeks directions that;

1. The RBC Entities have leave to adduce in evidence in their defences to the claim of Mr Nasser Azam made in the Royal Court in Jersey, confidential information in its possession relating to the creation, administration and management of the settlement known as the Nasser Azam Pension Plan by way of;

- (i) Providing discovery of documents;

- (ii) Disclosing confidential information in witnesses statements for use at trial in lieu of oral evidence in chief; and
- (iii) Disclosing confidential information in oral evidence in chief and/or cross examination.
