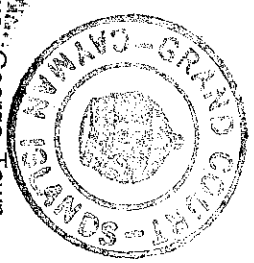
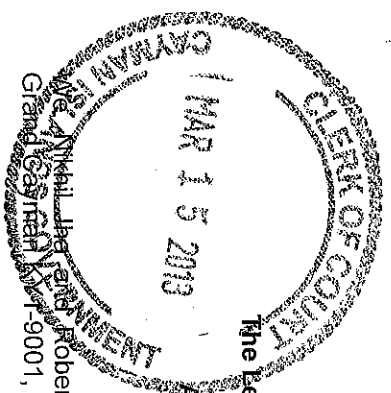

The Legal Practitioners (Students) Regulations (As Revised)

Application to be Admitted as an Attorney-at-Law

Section 3(1)(c) and Regulation 15(2)



Nikhil Jha and Robert Jackson of Walkers, Attorneys-at-Law, 190 Elgin Avenue, George Town, Grand Cayman KY-1-9001, Cayman Islands do solemnly and sincerely declare as follows:-

A. And I the said Nikhil Jha for myself do say that:-

- (1) I am one and the same person named as clerk in the Articles of Clerkship bearing the date 31st day of October 2011 and amended and registered on with effect from the 5th day of September 2011 now produced and shown to me marked with the letter "A".
- (2) The said Articles of Clerkship were registered pursuant to Regulation 16 on the 11th day of November 2011 with effect from the 5th day of September 2011.
- (3) On the 13th day of April 2012, the said Articles of Clerkship were transferred from Phillip Millward as Principal to Robert Jackson as Principal pursuant to a Transfer of Articles of Clerkship dated the 13th day of April 2012 with effect from the 5th day of September 2011 and registered pursuant to Regulation 16 on the 8th day of May 2012 now produced and shown to me marked with the letter "B".
- (4) Since the date of execution of the Articles of Clerkship I have been actually employed initially in the proper business practice and employment of Phillip Millward and, subsequent to his resignation from Walkers, I have been actually employed in the proper business practice and employment of Robert Jackson of Walkers, Attorneys-at-Law and have not held any other office or engaged in any other employment during that period.
- (5) I have never been convicted of a criminal offence.
- (6) I was awarded the Attorney-at-Law Certificate on the 6th day of March 2013 and a true copy of the same is now produced and shown to me marked with the letter "C".

B. And I the said Robert Jackson for myself do say:-

- (1) I am a practising attorney-at-law qualified under Section 16 of the Legal Practitioners Law (As Revised) to take a person into my service as an articulated clerk, and am the same person named as Principal in the Transfer of Articles of Clerkship now produced and shown to me marked with the letter "B".
- (2) The said Nikhil Jha was initially bound by articles to Phillip Millward and, subsequent to Mr Millward's resignation from the firm, Mr Jha has been bound by articles to me since the 13th day of April 2012 and has since that date been actually employed in my proper business practice and employment as an articulated clerk.
- (3) The period of articles which has been served satisfies the requirement of Regulation 17.
- (4) The said Nikhil Jha is a fit and proper person to be admitted as an attorney-at-law.

And we make this solemn declaration conscientiously believing the same to be true and by virtue of the Voluntary Declarations Law (As Revised).


