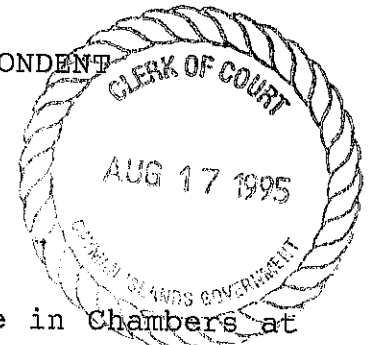
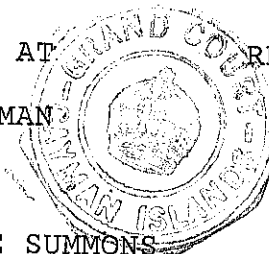

3. Such other relief and/or further Order as this Honourable Court may deem fit and just in all the circumstances.

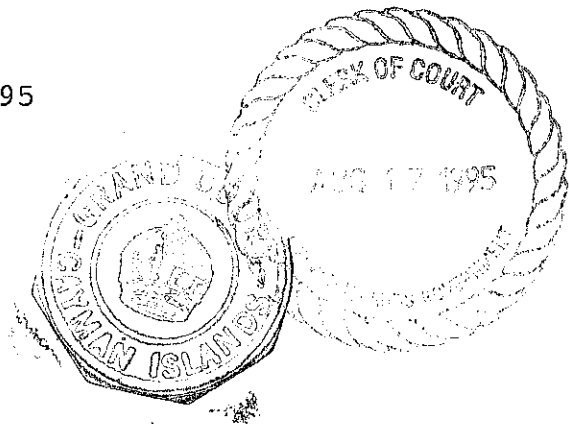
At the hearing of this Application the Applicant will refer to and rely on the Applicant's Affidavit sworn to on the 17th day of August 1995.
