1. That a declaration be made that the First and Second Defendant are in default of payment of the principal sum payable under a Charge registered on the 22nd October 2009 and shown by instrument #12231/09 made between BOTH Defendants and the Plaintiff by virtue of which the property in the Registration Section George Town Central Block 13D Parcel 331H20 was charged by both Defendants by way of a First Legal Charge in favour of the Plaintiff to secure the principal sum of C\$195,000.00 and interest at the rate specified in the schedule thereto.
2. That the First and Second Defendant deliver vacant possession of the Property to the Plaintiff
3. That the Charge be enforced by the sale by private treaty of the property registered at George Town Central Block 13D Parcel 331H20
4. That the terms and conditions of sale by private treaty be determined, if any.

5. That leave be granted to issue a Writ of Possession with respect to the property registered at George Town Central Block 13D Parcel 331H20
6. Such further or other relief as the Court thinks fit
7. Costs

AND LET THE DEFENDANTS within 28 days after service of this Summons on them counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts Office.
