ORDER FOR DIRECTIONS

UPON the Notice of Appointment for Assessment of Damages dated 31 May 2013 of Singularis Holdings Limited (in Official Liquidation) ("**the Plaintiff**")

AND UPON the application by the Plaintiff by their Summons dated 31 May 2013 for directions for the trial of the assessment of damages

AND UPON hearing Counsel for the Plaintiff and there being no appearance for the Defendant

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The trial of the assessment of damages is set down for hearing on Friday 26 July 2013 at 10.00am in open court before the Honourable Justice Foster.
2. The provisional estimated length of trial is one day. This includes two hours pre-trial reading time.
3. Where applicable, the parties shall serve notice of intention to adduce any hearsay evidence pursuant to GCR, O.38, r.21 by 24 June 2013.
4. Evidence at the trial of the assessment of damages may be given by affidavit pursuant to GCR, O.38, r.2 and, subject to any further order of the Court the deponents need not attend trial for cross examination.
5. The Plaintiff intending to rely at trial upon the First Affidavit of Stephen John Akers dated 10 October 2012 only (such evidence having been served upon the Defendant on 25 October 2012 pursuant to the Order of the Honourable Justice Foster dated the 23rd day of October 2012 for substituted service), the Defendant's affidavit evidence, if any, is to be filed and served by 28 June 2013.


6. The Plaintiff's evidence in reply, if any, is to be filed and served by 5 July 2013.
7. The Plaintiff's skeleton argument is to be delivered to the Honourable Justice Foster's secretary and served on the Defendant by 12 July 2013.
8. Trial Bundles are to be prepared by the Plaintiff and delivered to the Honourable Justice Foster's secretary by 12 July 2013.
9. The Defendant's skeleton argument is to be delivered to the Honourable Justice Foster's secretary and served on the Plaintiff by 22 July 2013.
10. Pursuant to the extant Order of the Honourable Justice Foster dated the 23rd day of October 2012 for substituted service, service of the Notice of Appointment for Assessment of Damages together with this Order for Directions on the Defendant:
 - (a) by way of hand delivery to Appleby (Cayman) Ltd, Clifton House, 75 Fort Street, George Town, PO Box 190, Grand Cayman, KY1-1104, Cayman Islands;
 - (b) by way of courier to Saad Trading Contracting & Financial Services Company, Salahuddin Al-Ayoubi Street, P.O. Box 3250, Al Khobar 31952, Saudi Arabia; and
 - (c) by way of hand delivery to Harbottle & Lewis LLP, 14 Hanover Square, London W1S 1HP, United Kingdom,

is deemed to be good and sufficient service on the Defendant pursuant to GCR Order 37, rule 1(2), and service shall be deemed to have been effected on the date on which delivery is made pursuant to paragraph 12(a) above.
