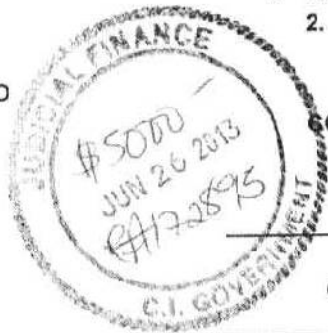


By this Summons, which is issued on the application of the Plaintiffs, Mr Abdulhady Taher of 1643 Brickell Avenue Apt 805 Miami Florida USA and Mr Ibrahim Taher of 26 Gilston Road West Brompton London SW10 9LS, the Plaintiffs seek the following relief under the Court's inherent supervisory jurisdiction and the above provisions:

1. An Order that the Defendant as trustee of the Settlement do provide to the Plaintiffs copies of the following documents:
  - a. The deed by which the Settlement was established;
  - b. The deed or other such document by which the interests of the Plaintiffs under the Settlement were revoked or by which the Plaintiffs were excluded as beneficiaries or from the class of beneficiaries of the Settlement;

- c. All documents relating to the appointment of a Protector or Enforcer (if any) of the Settlement.
  - d. All correspondence or other documents sent and received by the Defendant or any previous trustees in connection with the revocation of the interests of the Plaintiffs or the exclusion of the Plaintiffs as beneficiaries or from the class of beneficiaries of the Settlement;
  - e. All correspondence and other documentation relating to the establishment of the Settlement and/or any subsequent additions to the trust fund;
  - f. Any other supplemental deeds relating to the Settlement;
  - g. All resolutions of the Defendant or any previous trustees relating to the Settlement;
  - h. The accounts and financial statements relating to the Settlement; and
  - i. Any and all letters of wishes relating to the Settlement.
2. Such further or other orders as this Honourable Court think fit.
  3. That the costs of the Plaintiffs be paid out of the Settlement.

If the Defendant does not acknowledge service, such judgment may be given or order made against or in relation to it as the Court may think just and expedient.

**DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF SERVICE  
OF ORIGINATING SUMMONS**

The accompanying form of Acknowledgment of Service should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person. After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495 GT, George Town, Grand Cayman KY1-1104.

**Notes for Guidance**

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. If you wish to defend claims made in the originating summons, or intend to attend the proceedings and to participate in them so far as necessary (although not necessarily in an adversarial manner) you should tick the "Yes" box in paragraph 2 of the acknowledgment of service.
3. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
4. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Originating Summons)".
5. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.

**Notes on address for service**


Attorney: where the Defendant is represented by an attorney, state the attorney's place of business in the Cayman Islands. A Defendant may not act by a foreign attorney.
