


STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. Pursuant to promissory note dated the 1st September 1993 the Defendants agreed to repay to the Plaintiff the sum of CI\$58,000.00 together with interest thereon at the rate of 10%p.a by monthly instalments.
2. The Defendant have failed to maintain payment of the said monthly instalments and by reason of their default have become liable to pay the full amount due and owing under said promissory note being the sum of CI\$57,322.55.
3. Despite demand the Defendants have failed to make the aforesaid payments.

AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS:

1. The said sum of CI\$57,322.55.
2. Interest pursuant to Section 34(1) of the Judicature Law (1995) provision at 10% per annum at a daily rate of CI\$14.85 per day.
3. Costs.

If, within the time for returning the Acknowledgment of Service, the Defendant pays the total amount claimed of CI\$57,322.55 and CI\$938.25 in respect of costs and fees further proceedings will be stayed. The money must be paid to the Plaintiff or his Attorney.
