ORDER

UPON the Amended Summons of Cybernaut Capital Management Limited (the "**General Partner**") and the Amended Summons of Oriental Financial Holding Corporation ("**Oriental**"), each dated 25 June 2013 (the "**Summonses**")

AND UPON hearing the Summons of the General Partner dated 27 June 2013 (the "**Evidence Summons**")

AND UPON the Court calling for a case management conference in connection with these proceedings

AND UPON hearing Counsel for Partners Group Access Secondary 2008, L.P., Partners Group Access 89, L.P., Partners Group Maple Leaf Secondary Fund II, L.P. Inc., Partners Group Access IV L.P. and Partners Group Global Value SICAV (together, the "**Petitioners**"), Counsel for the General Partner and Counsel for Oriental

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1 The Summonses be dismissed.

THIS ORDER was filed by Maples and Calder, attorneys for the Petitioners, whose address for service is PO Box 309, Uglund House, Grand Cayman, KY1-1104, Cayman Islands. (Ref: MJC/LRS/KKW/672125.000004/27615236).

- 2 The Evidence Summons be dismissed.
- 3 The costs of and incidental to the Summonses and the Evidence Summons be reserved.
- 4 The period for the General Partner and/or Oriental to seek leave to appeal against the Orders in paragraphs 1 and 2 above shall be extended until 14 days following the determination of the Petition.
- 5 Paragraph 1 of the Order of this Honourable Court dated 25 June 2013 be extended until 4pm on 25 July 2013 and the parties shall have liberty to apply further in connection with the said Order and the Petitioners' Summons dated 21 June 2013.
- 6 The parties shall confer and agree upon the means by which the trial of the Petition shall be recorded and transcribed.
- 7 The parties shall have liberty to apply in connection with any further directions for the trial of the Petition.
