PETITION



To the Grand Court of the Cayman Islands

THE HUMBLE PETITION OF Phillip Ebanks (Voluntary Liquidator), P.O. Box 32148, Grand Cayman KY1 – 1208, Cayman Islands, shows that:

1. The Company, registration number 254016, was incorporated on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of March 2011 as an Ordinary Company with limited liability pursuant to the laws of the Cayman Islands.
2. Prior to the 5<sup>th</sup> September 2013 the registered office of the Company was Unit 11, Galleria Plaza, 638 West Bay Road, P.O. Box 30310, Grand Cayman KY1 -1202.
3. The Company is in the business of providing medical services. The objects for which the company was established are unrestricted.
4. On the date on which voluntary liquidation commenced the directors were as follows:
  - Rebecca Smith, P.O. Box 30289, Grand Cayman KY1-1202
  - Phillip Ebanks, P.O. Box 32148, Grand Cayman KY1 – 1208
  - David Bonner, Houston, Texas, USA.
5. The Shareholders of the Company are Stematix OT (40%), Phillip Ebanks (30%) and Rebecca Smith (30%).
6. In the premises:
  - a. The Company has duly resolved by ordinary resolution that it should be wound up voluntarily pursuant to Section 116 (d) of the Companies Law (2012 Revision) (the “Law”) and

- b. The voluntary winding up of the Company is deemed to have commenced on the 5<sup>th</sup> September 2013 pursuant to Section 117(1)(a) of the Law.
7. The Petitioner can confirm that no declaration of solvency has been received and that the company remains insolvent. The Petitioner therefore seeks an order for supervision of the winding up of the Company pursuant to Section 124 of the Law.
8. The Petitioner is not a qualified insolvency practitioner. Matthew Wright and Christopher Kennedy, as qualified insolvency practitioners at Rawlinson & Hunter, P.O. Box 897, Windward 1, Regatta Office Park, Grand Cayman, KY1 – 1103 are therefore nominated for appointment as official liquidators.
9. The above nominated individuals have confirmed their consent to act as Official Liquidators.
10. The Petitioner believes that it is appropriate in all the circumstances set out above that the liquidation of the Company should continue under the supervision of the Court.

Your Petitioner therefore humbly prays that:

- (1) Pursuant to Section 124 of the Law an Order that the liquidation continue under the supervision of the Court;
- (2) An Order that Matthew Wright and Christopher Kennedy be appointed as Joint Official Liquidators of the Company and that the powers bestowed on the Joint Official Liquidators may be exercised by them jointly and severally and within and outside the Cayman Islands;
- (3) The Voluntary Liquidator's costs be paid out of the assets of the Company as an expense of the liquidation.
- (4) Such further or alternative Orders and/or directions as this Honourable Court may think fit.
