Let All Parties Concerned attend before the Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the 4<sup>v</sup> day of *November* 2013 at o'clock on the hearing of an application on the part of the applicant, Sandra Bodden, for the following orders and directions:

1. The appointment of the applicant as the guardian and receiver of Alton Churchill Bodden ("the Patient") with the power to:
  - (a) control and manage any property of the Patient;
  - (b) sell, acquire, charge or otherwise dispose of or deal with any property of the Patient;
  - (c) invest the proceeds of sale or any monies belonging to the Patient in such securities as the Applicant for the time being is authorized by law to invest such funds;
  - (d) deposit into and withdraw from any account at any bank or lending institution in the Cayman Islands and elsewhere such of the Patient's monies as may be necessary for the proper maintenance and care of the Patient.
2. Such other directions as may be necessary in order to make provision for the financial affairs of Alton Churchill Bodden; and
3. Such consequential directions as may be necessary.
