
By this Summons, which is issued on the application of Barfield Nominees Limited and Virginia Molino as Trustee for the McKinsey Master Retirement Trust of 55 East, 52<sup>nd</sup> Street, New York, United States of America ("the Plaintiffs"), in their capacity as limited partners of Westford Special Situations Master Fund LP, the Plaintiffs seek from the Court the following Orders for the production of certain documents and information from the Defendant in its capacity as the general partner of Westford Special Situations Master Fund LP covering the period commencing from 17 March 2010 to the date of the Orders referred to below.



1. Delivery of the register relating to Westford Special Situations Master Fund LP of M&C Corporate Services Limited, P.O Box 309GT, Uglund House, George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands ("**the Partnership**") in accordance with Section 11 of the Exempted Limited Partnership Law (2012 Revision) ("**the ELP Law**").
2. Delivery of the books of accounts, including, where applicable, material underlying documentation including contracts and invoices, with respect to:
  - a) all sums of money received and expended by the Partnership and matters in respect of which the receipt of expenditure takes place;
  - b) all sales and purchases of goods by the Partnership; and
  - c) the assets and liabilities of the Partnership;in accordance with Section 12 of the ELP Law.
3. Delivery of the books of accounts, annual reports and quarterly investment reports describing the Partnership's activities in accordance with Section 8.1 of the Partnership's Confidential Limited Partnership Agreement dated 1 January 2009.
4. Costs.
5. Such further or other order as the Court sees fit.

If the Defendant does not acknowledge service, such judgment may be given or order made against or in relation to him as the Court may think just and expedient.

Attorney: where the Defendant is represented by an attorney, state the attorney's place of business in the Cayman Islands. A Defendant may not act by a foreign attorney.



## **DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF SERVICE OF ORIGINATING SUMMONS**

The accompanying form of Acknowledgment of Service should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person. After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, PO Box 495GT, George Town, Grand Cayman.

### **Notes for Guidance**

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. If you wish to defend claims made in the originating summons, or intend to attend the proceedings and to participate in them so far as necessary (although not necessarily in an adversarial manner) you should tick the "Yes" box in paragraph 2 of the acknowledgment of service.
3. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
4. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Originating Summons)".
5. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
7. Where the Defendant is a LIMITED COMPANY the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.

8. Where the Defendant is a MINOR or a MENTAL PATIENT, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a guardian *ad litem*.
9. A Defendant acting in person may obtain help in completing the form at the Courts Office.
