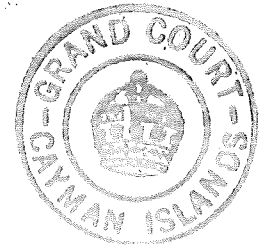

ORDER

UPON hearing Counsel for Kenneth Krys and Margot MacInnis acting in their capacities as the Joint Official Liquidators of Old World Properties Ltd (the "Company") and the Trustee's Agents in acting respect of the Bankrupt Estates of Patricia H. Millard and William H. Millard (FSD Nos. 60 and 61 of 2013) ("the Bankrupt Estates" and "the Bankruptcy Proceedings") on the summons dated 21 November 2013 (the "Summons")

AND UPON hearing Counsel for the Government of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands

AND UPON reading the First Affidavit of Kenneth Krys sworn on 22 November 2013

AND UPON the Court being satisfied that the whole of the issued share capital of the Company ("the Shares") is comprised in the Bankrupt Estates and has vested in the Trustee in Bankruptcy

AND UPON the Court having made an order in the Bankruptcy Proceedings authorising the Trustee's Agents to sell the Shares


IT IS ORDERED that:-

1. The sale of the Shares shall not be avoided by section 99 of the Companies Law and the Joint Official Liquidators are hereby authorised and directed to take all such steps as may be necessary or appropriate to complete the sale and register the Shares in the name of the purchaser.

2. Upon completion of the sale of the Shares, the Joint Official Liquidators shall apply forthwith for an order that the liquidation of the Company be permanently stayed.
3. That the Joint Official Liquidators' costs of and arising from the Summons be paid out of the assets of the Company as an expense of the liquidation.
