




Permanent Residency Board Appeal Statement and or Defence in accordance with the Immigration Law;

- (3) That the Decisions of The Immigration Appeals Tribunal and the Caymanians Status and Permanent Residency Board are unlawful under the Caymanian Constitution Order 2009 and the Decisions are incompatible with the European Convention of Human Rights.

And The Applicant Therefore Prays that:

1. He be Granted leave to extend the time to Appeal herein;
2. Intrim relief in the form of an injunction pending the final determination of this application and any further formal application, restraining the Chief immigration Officer and/or any Immigration Officer and/or Servant or agent or any of them whomsoever, from sending the Applicant out of the Cayman Islands until these proceedings for leave to extend the time to appeal or any order of the Court are heard and determined;
3. A declaration that the applicant be allowed to continue his employment with Celebrations Group Ltd under Operation of law on a Temporary basis pending the outcome of this application and any Order of Court;
4. Such further or other relief as the Court deem proper.
