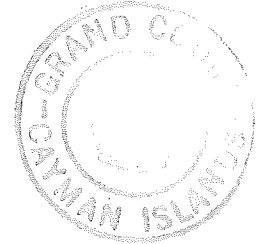

SUPERVISION ORDER

UPON hearing the Supervision Petition dated 25th October 2013 in relation to Island Taste Ltd ("the Company").

AND UPON reading the First Affidavit of Kevin Doyle ("the Voluntary Liquidator") sworn 25th October 2013, the First Affidavits of Christopher Kennedy and Matthew Wright sworn on 22nd October 2013 and the respective exhibits thereto.

AND UPON the Court being satisfied that the Petition has been duly advertised.

AND UPON hearing Counsel for the Voluntary Liquidator

IT IS ORDERED that:-

1. The liquidation should continue under the supervision of the Court.
2. Matthew Wright (Mathew.wright@rawlinson-hunter.com.ky) and Christopher Kennedy (chris.kennedy@rawlinson-hunter.com.ky) of RHSW (Cayman) Ltd of Windward 1, Regatta Office Park, P.O. Box 897, Grand Cayman, KY1 1103, (Tel: 345 9497576) are appointed as Joint Official Liquidators ("JOLs") of the Company and they may exercise their powers jointly and severally.
3. The JOLs may exercise the following powers specified in Part I of Schedule 3 to the Companies Law (2013 Revision) without further sanction of the Court:-
 - a. to sell any of the Company's property by public auction or private contract with power to transfer the whole of it to any person or to sell the same in parcels; and
 - b. to engage staff (whether or not as employees of the Company) to assist them in the performance of their functions.

This Supervision Order is filed by Priestleys, Attorneys at Law for the Petitioner whose address for service is P.O. Box 30310, Unit 11 & 12, Galleria Plaza, 638 West Bay Road, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands, KY1-1202

- c. to engage attorneys and other professionally qualified persons to assist them in the performance of their functions.
4. The JOLs shall report to the Court on the progress of the liquidation at least every six months from the date of this order and within a reasonable time thereafter shall apply to the Court for approval of their remuneration in respect of the period covered by each such report.
5. Subject to complying with the requirements of CWR O.15, rrs. 6 and 7, the Voluntary Liquidator shall be discharged from the performance of any further duties.
6. The Voluntary Liquidator's costs of and incidental to the Petition shall be paid out of the assets of the Company as an expense of the liquidation, such costs to be taxed if not agreed with the JOLs.
