ORDER FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF PROVISIONAL LIQUIDATORS

UPON hearing counsel for Zukiapa Management Limited upon its Summons dated 20th June 2014 for an order that Kris Beighton and Alexander Lawson be appointed joint provisional liquidators of VC Computer Holdings Limited (the "Company")

AND UPON hearing counsel for the Company

AND UPON reading the Petition, the Summons, the 1st and 2nd affidavits of Dr Olga Finkel, the 1st affidavit of Kris Beighton and the 1st affidavit of Alexander Lawson, the 1st affidavit of Mikhail Krasnov, the 1st affidavit of Natalia Terekhova, the 1st affidavit of Gina Athey, the 1st and 2nd affidavits of Astrid Stewart and the 1st affidavit of Ben Hobden

AND UPON the petitioner/applicant undertaking by its counsel to pay any damage suffered by the Company as a result of this order and/or the appointment of provisional liquidators in the event that the winding up petition is ultimately withdrawn or dismissed.

IT IS ORDERED that:-

1. Kris Beighton and Alexander Lawson of KPMG, P.O. Box 493, Century Yard, Cricket Square, Grand Cayman KY1-1106, Cayman Islands (+1345 815 2667) be appointed provisional liquidators of the Company (the "Joint Provisional Liquidators").




2. The Joint Provisional Liquidators are hereby authorized:
 - a. to exercise any of the powers set out at paragraphs 1, 2, 3, 4 and 7 of Part II of Schedule 3 of the Companies Law (2013 Revision);
 - b. to exercise the powers set out in paragraph 11 of Part I, Schedule 3 of the Companies Law (2013 Revision); and
 - c. to exercise the power set out in paragraph 1 of Part I, Schedule 3 of the Companies Law (2013 Revision) to the extent that the exercise of such power is incidental to collecting or securing the Company's assets and/or property (whether in the Cayman Islands or outside of the Cayman Islands) or information in relation thereto.
3. Without prejudice to the powers and functions set out herein, the Joint Provisional Liquidators' powers shall extend to:
 - a. locating, collecting, protecting, securing and taking possession of all of the Company's books and records and other papers including all accounting, banking and statutory records;
 - b. investigating the affairs of the Company including, for the avoidance of doubt, its dealings with any company in or formerly in or affiliated to the Vercysell Group of companies (as set out in the Appendix to this Order) (the "Vercysell Group") , any shareholder of Sakaras Holding Limited or any person that appears to be a director or officer of a company in the Vercysell Group or such shareholder;
 - c. applying to the Courts in Cyprus, Malta, Russia, Switzerland or elsewhere for recognition of their appointment; and
 - d. applying to any foreign court pursuant to their powers and functions.
4. During the period of their appointment, any act required or authorised to be done by the Joint Provisional Liquidators may be done by any one or more of the Joint Provisional Liquidators.

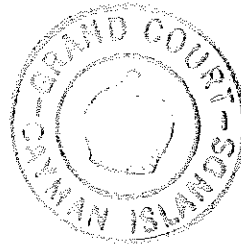
5. The Company shall disclose the following information in writing to the Joint Provisional Liquidators by 5pm on Monday, 21 July 2014:
 - a. confirmation of (i) the location(s) of storage of all of the Company's books and records (both hard copy and electronic records), including those held by any agent of the Company and (ii) the name and full contact details of the person(s) (a) in control of the premises at which such records are stored and (b) with authority to provide the Joint Provisional Liquidators with access to such books and records and to release such books and records to them; and
 - b. a list of all bank accounts now or at any time since 1 March 2007 held by the Company in any jurisdiction along with full contact details of the banks with which such accounts were held.
6. A hearing for directions in the Petition shall be listed for 4 August 2014 at 10:00 am.
7. The Petitioner's costs of this application be paid by the Company in any event.
