ORIGINATING SUMMONS


LET THE DEFENDANTS, (1) Mayer Holdings Limited ("Mayer") of M&C Corporate Services Limited, PO Box 309, Ugland House, Grand Cayman, KY1-1104, Cayman Islands and (2) Mayer Corporation Development International Limited ("Mayer BVI") of TMF Corporate Services (BVI) Limited, Palm Grove House, PO Box 438, Road Town, Tortola, VG1110, British Virgin Islands attend before the Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the day of 2014, at o'clock on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiffs (1) Aspial Investment Limited ("Aspial") of Mossack Fonseca & Co (BVI) Ltd, Akara Building, 24 de Castro Street, Wickhams Cay 1, Road Town, Tortola, British Virgin Islands and (2) Bumper East Limited ("Bumper") of Offshore Incorporations Limited, PO Box 957, Offshore Incorporations Centre, Road Town, Tortola, British Virgin Islands for an order that:

1. Pursuant to section 46 of the Companies Law (2013 Revision) (the "Law"), the Register of Members of Mayer be rectified by striking out the name Mayer Corporation Development International Limited in respect of 200 million shares held by it and inserting in lieu thereof the name of Aspial Investment Limited as holder of 100 million shares numbered MAN00004971 and the name of Bumper East Limited as holder of 100 million shares numbered MAN00004970;

2. Pursuant to section 46 of the Law, that there be an inquiry as to any loss or damage sustained by the Plaintiffs as a result of having been omitted from the Register of Members of Mayer and an order that the First and/or the Second Defendant do pay to the Plaintiffs any damages found to be due to the Plaintiffs upon such inquiry having been made;
3. The cost of this Originating Summons be paid by the Defendants;
4. There be such further or alternative relief granted as the Court shall think fit.

AND LET THE FIRST DEFENDANT within 14 days and the SECOND DEFENDANT within 28 days after service of this summons, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service to the Courts office.

- 1) This Summons may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the above date unless renewed by order of the Court.
- 2) If a defendant does not attend personally or by his attorney at the time and place abovementioned such order will be made as the Court may think just and expedient.

OF ORIGINATING SUMMONS

The accompanying form of Acknowledgment of Service should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person. After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495, George Town, Grand Cayman.

Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. If you wish to defend claims made in the originating summons, or intend to attend the proceedings and to participate in them so far as necessary (although not necessarily in an adversarial manner) you should tick the "Yes" box in paragraph 2 of the acknowledgement of service.
3. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
4. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Originating Summons)".
5. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of ()" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as ()" after his name.


Notes on address for service

Attorney: Where the Defendant is represented by an attorney, state the attorney's place of business in the Cayman Islands. A Defendant may not act by a foreign attorney.


