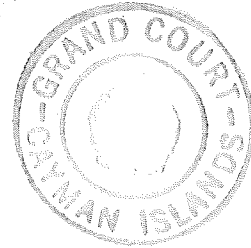

AND UPON the Plaintiff undertaking in the terms set out in the Schedule hereto


IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Pursuant to Order 11 of the Grand Court Rules the Plaintiff is granted leave to serve the Writ in this proceeding out of the jurisdiction on the Defendant by way of personal service at Adura Lere House, 12 Ruxton Road, Ikoyi, Lagos, Nigeria.

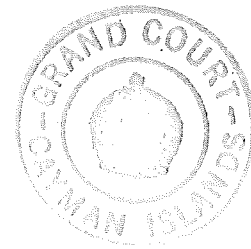
2. Copies of the affidavits of Jane Hale-Smith together with the exhibits thereto; the Plaintiff's ex parte Summonses; and the skeleton argument filed in support thereof shall be served on the Defendant with the Writ filed herein.
3. The Defendant shall have 28 days after the service of the Writ on him, counting the day of service, to acknowledge service of the Writ.
4. The Defendant is prohibited from in any way (whether directly or indirectly) dealing with or otherwise prejudicing any distributions from or rights in relation to the Lifeboat Settlement from which he may benefit (whether directly or indirectly) or which he may exercise (whether or not for his benefit).
5. The Defendant be at liberty to apply to discharge or vary this Order on 7 days' notice to the Plaintiff's attorneys.
6. Costs in the cause.

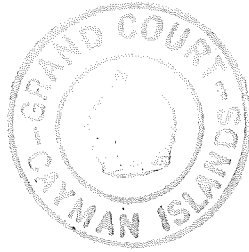
