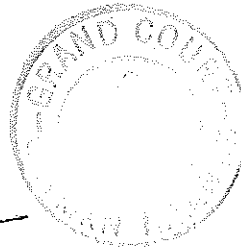
AND UPON hearing Counsel for the Minority Shareholders
