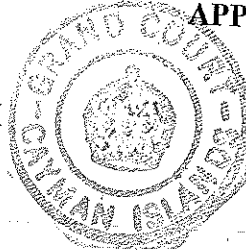

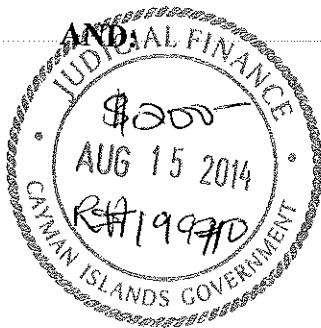

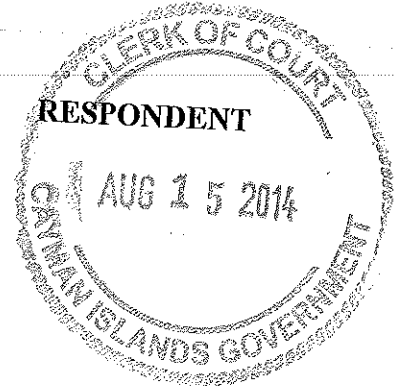

NOTICE OF APPEAL


TAKE NOTICE that the Grand Court will be moved so soon as Counsel can be heard on behalf of the above named Appellant on an Appeal from the Decision of the Immigration Appeals Tribunal herein dated the 15th day of July 2014, whereby it was adjudged that:-

1. The Tribunal reviewed the Appeal Statement dated 14th July 2009 which outlined the reasoning behind the decision to refuse the application and that the Tribunal reviewed the Notice of Appeal dated 10th December 2008 and Grounds of Appeal dated 11th October 2010 and decided that insufficient grounds of appeal had been established, pursuant to section 15(2) and 16(4) of the Immigration Law 2013 Revision, and accordingly dismissed the Appeal brought by the Appellant; in disregard of the provisions contained in paragraph 9 of the Immigration Regulations 2006 under the heading "General" as it relates to the award of points to the Appellant.

FOR AN ORDER THAT:

1. the Respondent's Decision to dismiss the Appellant's appeal be quashed;
2. costs in the matter;
3. there be such further or other relief as the Honourable Grand Court shall think fit.
