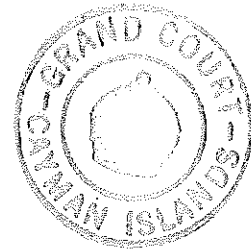

2 The following minute is hereby approved:


