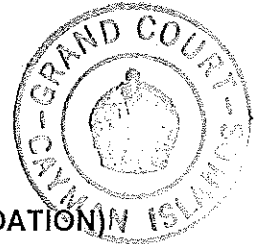

AND UPON HEARING Counsel for the Defendant and Counsel for the Plaintiff;

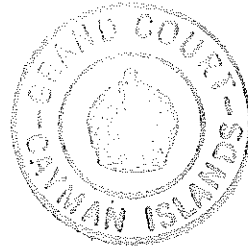


IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The Dismissal Summons is adjourned to a date to be fixed with a time estimate of one hour;
2. The Plaintiff shall file any evidence as to the reasons for the Plaintiff's failure to comply with the Unless Order of this Court dated 21 May 2014 forthwith; and
3. The costs of and occasioned by the Dismissal Summons shall be the Defendant's in any event, and the issue of whether costs should be assessed on a standard or indemnity basis is reserved.
