

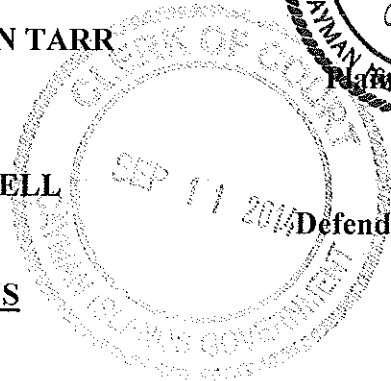
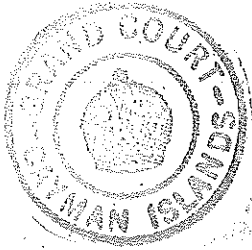
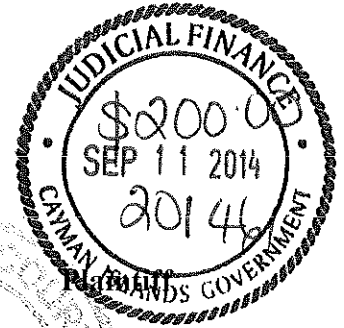

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out of the next page.

Within 14 days after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

1. This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

CONCISE STATEMENT OF CLAIM


1. A full Statement of Claim will follow.
2. The Plaintiff claims damages for personal injury and consequential losses arising out of a motor vehicle accident that occurred on 23rd September 2011 in the vicinity of Huldah Avenue in George Town, Grand Cayman.
3. The Plaintiff was driving a Honda Civic motor car. Registration number 11566 and the Defendant was driving a Chevrolet Tahoe SUV motor car, registration number 111886.
4. The Plaintiff's vehicle was positioned the right hand lane heading north towards Cayman National Bank Roundabout when the Defendant's vehicle, which was travelling south along Huldah Avenue toward Bobby Thompson Way, drove into a head-on collision with the Plaintiff's vehicle.
5. The collision was caused by the negligence of the First Defendant who was subsequently convicted for driving under the influence of alcohol at the the time of the accident.
6. As a result of the collision, the Plaintiff suffered a broken neck, dislocated left hip and shoulder and cuts to his left knee. He was taken, by ambulance, to George

Town Hospital and flown to Jackson Memorial Hospital in Florida the following day for further treatment.

7. As a result of the aforementioned accident, the Plaintiff suffered loss and damage.
8. Further, the Plaintiff claims interest pursuant to Section 34 of the Judicature Law (2007) Revision at such rate and for such period as this Honourable Court deems just.

AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS:-

1. General Damages for personal injury;
2. Special Damages;
3. Interest; and
4. Costs.
