

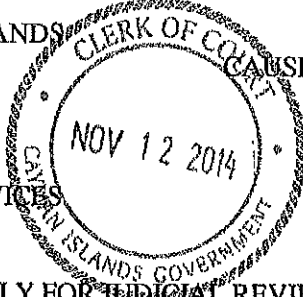

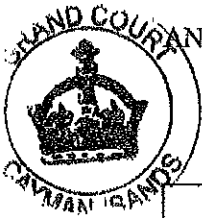

This Judicial Review is sought pursuant the breaches made to the Cayman Islands Procedural Code and Police Law.

Decision Against which this Application is Made

On Thursday 20 December 2012, Royal Cayman Islands Police Services Plain Clothes Officers showed up in my physical address -back then- on Birchwood rd at Sunshine Apartments, I was not there at the moment cause I was at work with Cayman Electronic Services, when I returned home early next morning my rental mates informed me, I was surprised and then decided to go to Central Police Station (GTPS) in GT immediately. I had to wait for a Detective around 1 hour, then the Detectives told me that another Officer from Bodden Town Police Station (BTPS) was looking for me, they proceeded to arrest and process me -I was not informed about why I was arrested, neither I
