

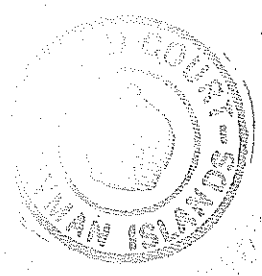

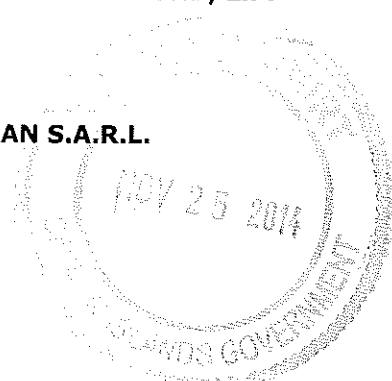


LET THE DEFENDANT, within 14 days after service of this Summons on it, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service to the Courts Office, PO Box 495g, George Town, Grand Cayman.

By this Originating Summons, which is issued on the application of aeris CAPITAL Blue Ocean S.a.r.l. of 2 rue Heinrich Heine, L-1720, Luxembourg, the Plaintiffs seek the determination of the Court on the following questions and the following relief:

1. A declaration that, the Notice of Compulsory Withdrawal dated 31 October 2014 and issued by Silver Reel GP Ltd to the Plaintiff (**the Notice**) is invalid and of no effect.
2. Any amendments made to the Amended and Restated Limited Partnership Agreement dated 28 July 2011 (**the LPA**) in respect of which the Plaintiff would have been entitled to vote but for the Notice are invalid and of no effect.
3. A declaration that, the Plaintiff's redemption request dated 16 December 2013 be given effect in accordance with the provisions of the LPA, as they stood at that date.
4. Such further or other relief as the Court shall deem fit; and
5. An order that the costs of this Originating Summons be paid by the Defendant to the Plaintiff.

If the Defendant does not acknowledge service, such Judgment may be given or order made against or in relation to him as the Court may think just and expedient.

OF ORIGINATING SUMMONS**

The accompanying form of Acknowledgement of Service should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person. After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, PO BOX 495g, George Town, Grand Cayman.

Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgement of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. If you wish to defend claims made in the Originating Summons, or intend to attend the proceedings and to participate in them so far as necessary (although not necessarily in an adversarial manner) you should tick the "Yes" box in paragraph 2 of the acknowledgement of service.
3. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
4. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Originating Summons)".
5. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
