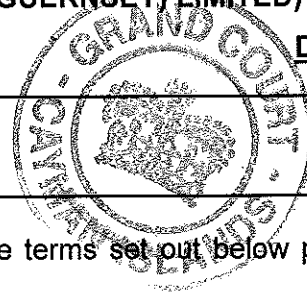

3. Each party do have liberty to apply.

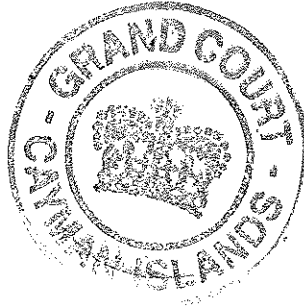
4. Costs be in the cause.
