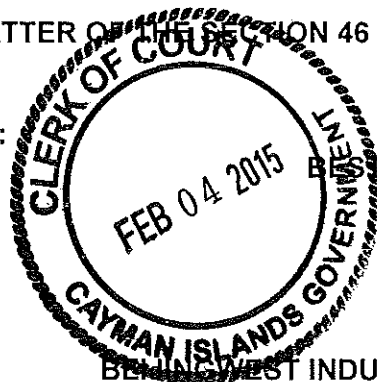

ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET THE DEFENDANT BeijingWest Industries International Limited (formerly known as Norstar Founders Group Limited) of Codan Trust Company (Cayman) Limited, Cricket Square, Hutchins Drive, PO Box 2681, Grand Cayman KY1-1111, Cayman Islands attend before the Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the day of 2015, at o'clock on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiff pursuant to Section 46 of the Companies Law (as amended) for the following orders:

1. That the Defendant within 7 days do rectify its register of members to record the transfer of 9,000,000 shares of the Defendant from the name of Mark Up Investments Limited ("**Mark Up**") into the name of the Plaintiff and the transfer of 54,000,000 shares of the Defendant from the name of Century Founders Group Limited ("**Century Founders**") into the name of the Plaintiff.
2. That within 7 days of the steps referred to in paragraph 1 above, the Defendant instruct or procure Tricor Investor Services Limited to rectify the branch register it holds of the Defendant's members in accordance with paragraph 1 above.
3. That the Defendant within 14 days issue share certificates to the Plaintiff in respect of the shares referred to in paragraph 1 above.

4. Such further and other relief that the Court deems fit.
5. No order as to costs.

AND LET THE DEFENDANT within 14 days after service of this summons on him counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts office, PO Box 495GT, George Town, Grand Cayman.

DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF SERVICE
OF ORIGINATING SUMMONS

The accompanying form of Acknowledgment of Service should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person. After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, PO Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman.

Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. If you wish to defend claims made in the originating summons, or intend to attend the proceedings and to participate in them so far as necessary (although not necessarily in an adversarial manner) you should tick the "Yes" box in paragraph 2 of the acknowledgment of service.
3. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
4. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Originating Summons)".
5. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
7. Where the Defendant is a LIMITED COMPANY the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.
8. Where the Defendant is a MINOR or a MENTAL PATIENT, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a guardian ad litem.
9. A Defendant acting in person may obtain help in completing the form at the Courts Office.

Attorney: where the Defendant is represented by an attorney, state the attorney's place of business in the Cayman Islands. A Defendant may not act by a foreign attorney.

Defendant in person: where the Defendant is acting in person, he must give his post office box number and the physical address of his residence or, if he does not reside in the Cayman Islands, he must give an address in Grand Cayman where communications for him should be sent. In the case of a limited company, "residence" means its registered principal office.
