**NOTICE OF APPEAL**


**TAKE NOTICE** that I, Sandra Catron, intend to appeal against the order of the Summary Court dated 30<sup>th</sup> January 2015 filed 9<sup>th</sup> March 2015 and served 27<sup>th</sup> March 2015.

The grounds of my appeal are as follows:

1. The learned Magistrate erred in finding that the written agreement of 7<sup>th</sup> November 2011 had not been varied by the parties, and therefore further erred in dismissing the Appellant's plaint;
2. The learned Magistrate erred in finding that a separate contract governed the additional students that the parties had agreed the Appellant would train;
3. The learned Magistrate erred in finding that the Appellant was in the role of a sponsorship administrator under the written agreement of 7<sup>th</sup> November 2011;

4. The learned Magistrate erred in deciding the threshold of the Appellant's obligation to students under the written agreement of 7<sup>th</sup> November 2011;
5. The learned Magistrate erred in making a finding of dishonesty against the Appellant over her dealings with completion certificates, and further erred in linking the completion certificates to an attempt to conceal a breach of contract by the Appellant;
6. The learned Magistrate erred in upholding the Respondent's counterclaim on the basis of findings that had not been pleaded by the Respondent; and
7. The learned Magistrate erred in awarding damages in favour of the Respondent in excess of those actually pleaded by the Respondent.
