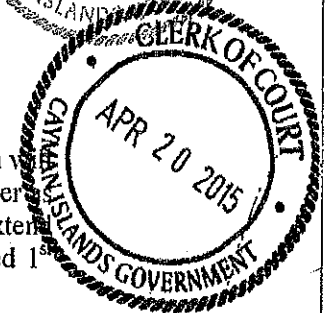
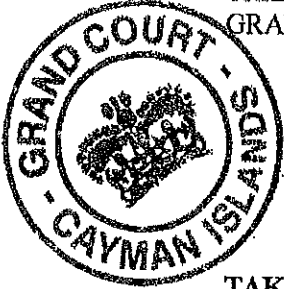


And Further Take Notice that the grounds on which the Appellant relies on in support of her Application for Leave to extend the time for appeal are as follows:-

1. The Tribunal erred in Law in that it:
 - i. failed to ensure that the Appellant was notified of its decision "*within a reasonable period of time*" or at all, pursuant to section 16 (11) of the law.
 - ii. failed to provide the Appellant with a copy of the Board's Appeal Statement within the prescribed 28 days, pursuant to section 15(12) of the law.

And the Appellant Therefore Prays that:

1. She be granted leave to extend the time to Appeal herein; _____
2. An order directing the Department of Immigration to allow the Appellant to remain and work in the Cayman Islands until the determination of this application;
3. An order prohibiting the Department of Immigration from taking any further action(s) against the Appellant until the determination of this application;
4. Such further, consequential, or other relief this Honourable Court deems just.
