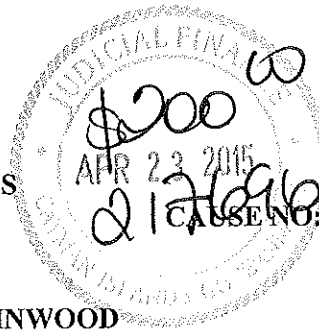

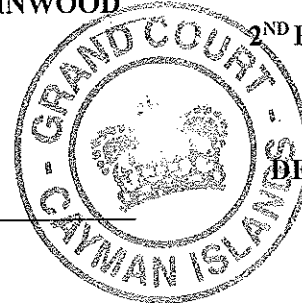
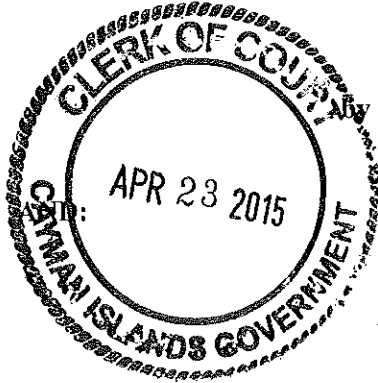

WRIT OF SUMMONS

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above named Plaintiffs, of 9 Candlewood Drive, Bodden Town, P.O. Box 11653, Grand Cayman KY1-1009 in respect of the claims set out on the next page.

Within 14 days after service of this Writ on you, (or where this Writ is served on you out of the jurisdiction pursuant to an Order of the Court, within 28 days) counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Courts Office, P.O. Box 495, George Town, Grand Cayman, KY1-1106, Cayman Islands the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein any intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

NOTE this Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of original issuance unless renewed by order of the Court

IMPORTANT

Directions for the Acknowledgement of service are given with the accompanying form.

AND THE PLAINTIFFS CLAIM:

That they each suffered personal injuries and damages in a motor vehicle accident which occurred as the result of the negligence of the Defendant in the operation of a Toyota Camry motor vehicle bearing registration plate number 111776 on 24 April 2012 on South Sound Road, in the vicinity of San Sebastian condo complex, in George Town, Grand Cayman, when the Defendant collided with the rear of the 1st Plaintiff's motor vehicle.

The Defendant's motor vehicle was required to be insured at the time pursuant to the Vehicle Insurance (Third Party Risks) Law (2012 Revision) and was so insured by Fidelity Insurance (Cayman) Limited.

The 1st Plaintiff's injuries include injuries to her neck/shoulder and low back with radiation into her right leg with numbness and tingling in her foot, resulting in chronic pain for which she has undergone steroid injections and radiofrequency ablation to her low back, nerve block injections to her shoulder, chiropractic and acupuncture and physiotherapy in an effort to alleviate her symptoms.


The 2nd Plaintiff's injuries include injury to her neck and mid and low back, resulting in chronic pain for which she has undergone physiotherapy and chiropractic treatment.

The Plaintiffs therefore claim:

- (a) General damages for pain and suffering and loss of amenities to be assessed;
- (b) Special damages;
- (c) Pre-judgment and post-judgment interest pursuant to s.34 of the Judicature Law (2013 Revision) and the Judgment Debts (Rates of Interest) Rules 2010 as more particularly pleaded above; and
- (d) Costs of this action.

Full particulars of the Plaintiffs' loss and damages will be provided in the Plaintiffs' Statement of Claim to be filed.
