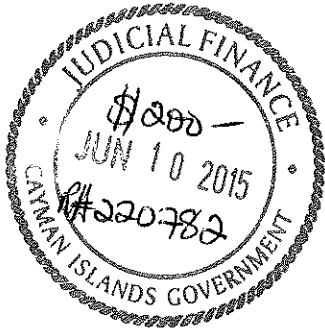

ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET THE DEFENDANTS, Stephen Wright, Vadlee Douglas, Rollin Ritch, within 14 days after service of this Summons on them, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service to the Court Office, PO Box 495, Grand Cayman KY1-1106.

BY THIS SUMMONS, which is issued on the application of Juliet Dorothy Ritch-Reed of PO Box 1270, Grand Cayman KY1-1503, Cayman Islands, the Plaintiff seeks the following relief:-

1. In or about 1974, the Estate of Thomas Matias Ritch (the Grandfather of the Petitioner) became the registered proprietor of certain land in Cayman Brac, which such land is now registered at the Lands & Survey Department as Cayman Brac East, Block 109A, Parcel 42 ("the Estate").
2. The Land Register for Parcel 42 was opened on 26 June 1974 upon first registration and the registered proprietors were Wilfred Ritch and the First Defendant, Stephen Wright, in their capacity as the joint Administrators of the Estate of Thomas Matias Ritch.
3. Wilfred Ritch died on 1st January 1986 and his name was deleted from the Land Register for the Estate in or about July 2006 and the First Defendant, Stephen Wright, became the Sole Administrator of the Estate.
4. An order was issued on 18th November 2008 by the Grand Court, at the petition of the Second Defendant, Vadlee Douglas and Third Defendant, Rollin Ritch that either or both be added to the

Land Register of the Estate in the capacity of Personal Representatives to ensure the rights of the beneficiaries were properly administered on behalf of the beneficiaries.

5. That as of the date of this Summons, seven years since the issuance of Administrator capacities for the Second and Third Defendant, and thirty-eight years since the issuance of Administrator capacity for the First Defendant, the Estate has not yet been administered on behalf of the beneficiaries. In addition, there has been absolutely no effort to contact, coordinate or involve the legal beneficiaries of the Estate in any matters relating to or being the cause of or dealings with or pertaining to, the Estate.
6. The Petitioner, being an immediate beneficiary of the Estate declares that the current Administrators have not successfully performed their duties as Personal Representatives of the Estate of Thomas Matias Ritch.
7. Given the above, the Plaintiff seeks an Order pursuant to Section 5 and Section 8 of the Succession Law (2006 Revision) that the First, Second and Third Defendants be removed from their capacity as Personal Representatives of the Estate.
8. And, given the above, the Plaintiff seeks an Order pursuant to Section 29 of the Succession Law (2006 Revision) to have the Estate vested in the names of the current, surviving beneficiaries.
9. Further or other relief.

If the Defendants do not acknowledge service, such judgement may be given or order made against or in relation to them as the Court may think just and expedient.
