

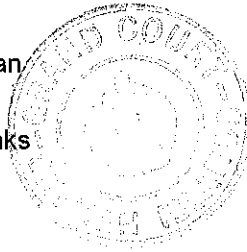



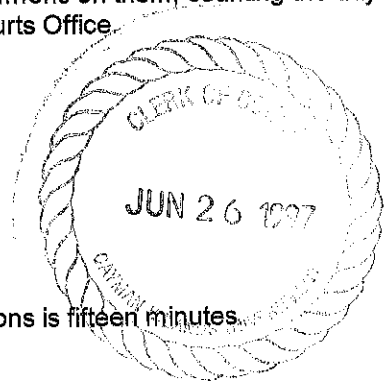

- 1.
