

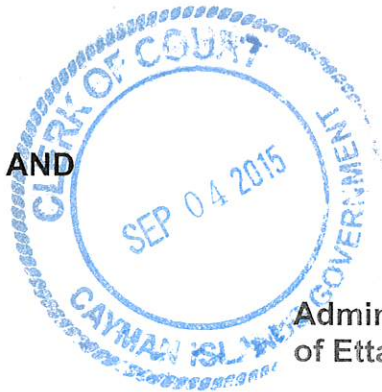

Within 14 days after service of this writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the court office, P.O Box 495 GT, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating that you intend to

contest these proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

### ENDORSEMENT

The Plaintiff's claim is for: -

- A. A declaration that she is entitled to a beneficial interest in property registered at East End, Block 72 C, Parcel 150 registered in the name of the Defendants, as Administrators in the Estate of **Etta Elaura McLean, deceased**.
- B. An injunction preventing the Defendants from acting on Notice to Vacate dated 8<sup>th</sup> July, 2015, seeking to remove the Plaintiff from occupation of the house / premises located on the subject property, until final determination of the matter herein.

NOTE: This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the court.

### Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
3. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (*the name stated on the Writ of Summons*)".
4. Where the Defendant is a **FIRM** and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a **PARTNER** by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
5. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual **TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN**, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is a **LIMITED COMPANY** the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on his behalf.
7. Where the Defendant is a **MINOR** or a **MENTAL PATIENT**, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a guardian *ad litem*.
8. A Defendant acting in person may obtain help in completing the form at the Courts Office.

**NOTES ON ADDRESS FOR SERVICE**

**Attorney:** Where the Respondent is represented by an Attorney, state the Attorney's place of business in the Cayman Islands. A Respondent may not act by a foreign Attorney.

**Respondent in person:** Where the Respondent is acting in person, he must give his post office box number and the physical address of his residence, or if he does not reside in the Cayman Islands, he must give an address in Grand Cayman where communications for him should be sent.
