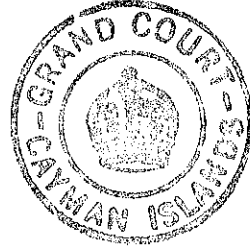

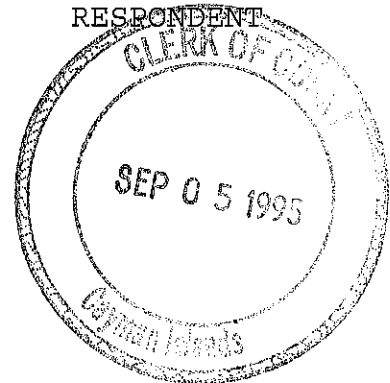

 - (i) payment within seven (7) days of all reinstatement fees and penalties to the Registrar of Companies; and

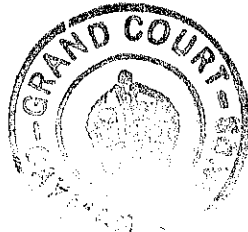

3. Such further order or orders as the Court may deem fit.

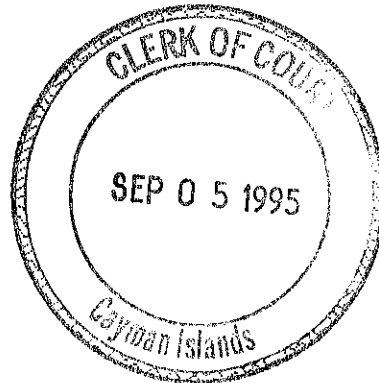
