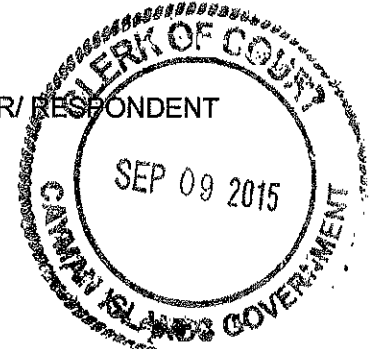
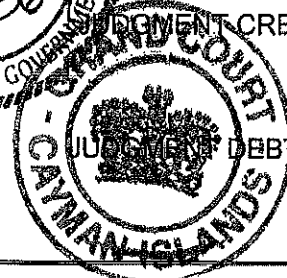
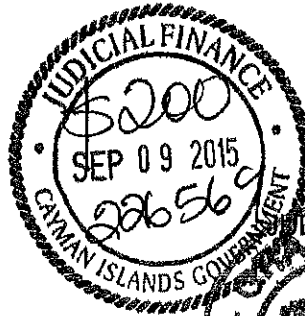

**EX PARTE ORIGINATING MOTION FOR A CHARGING ORDER,
PURSUANT TO GCR. O 50, R 1 (2)**

TAKE NOTICE that the Court at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman will be moved on the 19 day of October ~~September~~ 2015 at 9:30 o'clock in the forenoon/afternoon, or as soon thereafter as counsel can be heard, by counsel on behalf of Judgment Creditor/Plaintiff, PHILLIP WOOD, for order pursuant to Order 50 of the Grand Court Rules (1995 Revision) that:

1. the interests of the Judgment Debtor/Respondent in the Property at Registration Section George Town East, Block 20B Parcel 374 ("Property") do stand charged for:
 - (i) the sum of KYD74,098.24 which is outstanding and due to the Judgment Creditor/Plaintiff from the Judgment Debtor/Respondent, pursuant to the order of the Labour Tribunal of 29 May 2015 ("Order"); and
 - (ii) Interest on the sum of KYD \$37,049.12 (awarded as severance payment in the Order) at a rate of 10% per annum in accordance with section 42(2)(b) of the Labour Law (2011 Revision), for the period from 12 February 2014 until paid and coming to KYD5,866.11 as of 12 August 2015 and accruing at a daily rate of KYD10.15 thereafter.

2. the costs of this application be paid by the Judgment Debtor and that the Property do stand charged for such costs.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that the grounds of this application are that:

1. The Judgment Debtor has failed to comply with the order set out in the decision of the Labour Tribunal dated 29 May 2015 to pay to the Judgment Creditor/Plaintiff, PHILLIP WOOD:
 - (i) the sum of KYD37,049.12 awarded as severance pay.
 - (ii) The sum of KYD37,049.12 awarded unfair dismissal
 - (iii) Interest on the amount awarded as severance in accordance with the provisions of the Labour Law, at a rate of 10% per annum from the date of termination, being 12 February 2014 until all amounts payable are paid.

2. The Judgment Creditor/Plaintiff PHILLIP WOOD applies pursuant to Order 50 (and Section 76 (2) of the Labour Law) for enforcement by way of a charging order to attach to the Property to secure payment of the amount due and owing under the said order.
