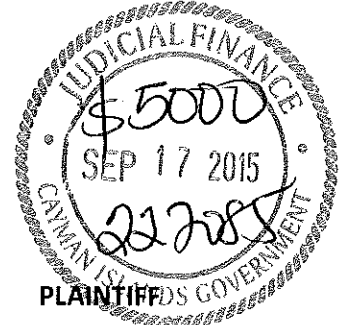

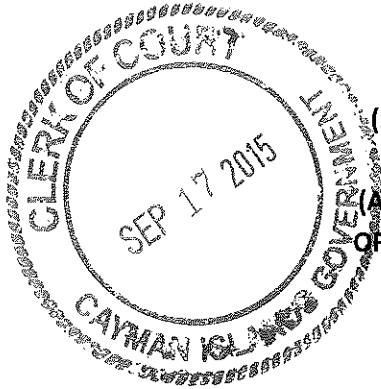

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**ORIGINATING SUMMONS**

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LET THE FIRST DEFENDANT, within 14 days after service of this Summons on him, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts office, PO Box 495, George Town, Grand Cayman.


LET THE SECOND DEFENDANT, within 28 days after service of this Summons on him, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts office, PO Box 495, George Town, Grand Cayman.

By this Originating Summons, which is issued on the application of the Plaintiff, Benedetta Cassara De Leggio, of Carlos Alberto Leggio Plaza, direccion Principe de Vergara 102 piso 3C, Madrid 28006, Spain, against the First Defendant, PetroUnion Limited (a Cayman Islands company with registered company number 60830) of Trident Trust Company (Cayman) Ltd, One Capital Place, PO Box 847, Grand Cayman KY1-1103, Cayman Islands, and the Second Defendant, Claudio Leggio (as personal representative of the late Francesco Leggio Lo Curto), the Plaintiff seeks the following orders:

1. That pursuant to section 46 of the Companies Law (2013 Revision) and section 29 of the Succession Law (2006 Revision), the Defendant's share register be rectified to record the Plaintiff as the owner of all of the shares (being the entire issued share capital of the Defendant, as at 18 January 2013) that were owned by the Plaintiff's late husband Francesco Leggio Lo Curto at the time of his death intestate on 18 January 2013;
2. That the Second Defendant shall realize and administer the estate of the late Francesco Leggio Lo Curto forthwith, by immediately satisfying any liabilities of the estate and then immediately distributing the residuary assets of the estate in accordance with the Succession Law;
3. That the Second Defendant shall within 28 days of this Order file in the office of the Clerk of the Court, and provide a copy to the Plaintiff via her attorneys, accounts in respect the estate of the late Francesco Leggio Lo Curto, showing the receipts and distributions of the estate, and verify those accounts by affidavit;
4. That unless the Second Defendant complies in full with Orders (2) and (3) above, the Second Defendant shall be removed as personal representative of the late Francesco Leggio Lo Curto with immediate effect;
5. Such further or other relief as the Court thinks fit; and
6. Costs.

If the Defendants (or any one of them) do not acknowledge service, such judgment may be given or order made against or in relation to them (or any one of them) as the Court may think just and expedient.
