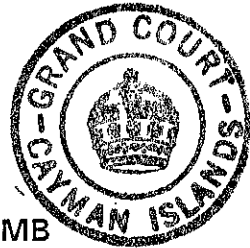

Within 14 days after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

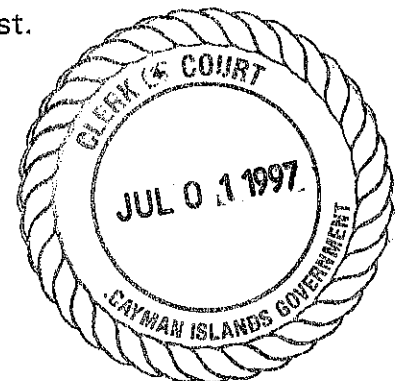
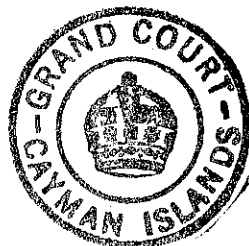
1. The Plaintiff's claim is for the sum US\$74,550.00 in respect of BCC Travellers Cheques issued by the Plaintiff to the Defendant pursuant to an Agreement between the Plaintiff and the Defendant which are to date unaccounted for by the Defendant as follows:-

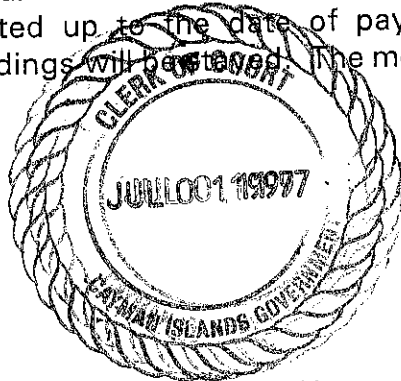
2. By letters to the Defendant, dated May 22, 1997 and June 10, 1997, the Plaintiff demanded payment of the sum of US\$74,550.00. To date no payment has been received.
3. Further and/or alternatively, an order that the Defendant do provide the Plaintiff with replacement banker's drafts for any drafts previously issued by the Defendant in respect of its liabilities arising out of the sale of Travellers Cheques herein.
4. Interest on the said sum of US\$74,550.00 pursuant to the Judgment Debts (Rates of Interest) Rules 1995 r.4(a) at a rate of 8 3/8% per annum for the period July 5, 1991 to January 31, 1996 namely US\$28,590.81, alternatively at such rate and for such period as the Court shall deem just.
5. Interest on the said sum of US\$74,550.00 pursuant to the Judgment Debts (Rates of Interest) Rules 1995 r.4(a) at a rate of 7 3/8% per annum for the period February 1, 1996 to June 30, 1997 namely US\$7,755.90, alternatively at such rate and for such period as the Court shall deem just.



AND THE PLAINTIFF claims:

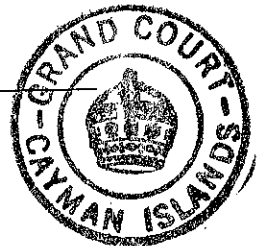
1. The said sum of US\$74,550.00 (under paragraph 1); US\$28,590.81 (under paragraph 3); US\$7,755.90 (under paragraph 4); being a total of US\$110,896.71 or CI\$93,153.24 (conversion rate is at US\$1.00 = CI\$ 0.84).
2. Further interest on the sum of US\$110,896.71 from July 1, 1997 at the rate of 7 3/8% p.a. pursuant to the Judgment Debts (Rates of Interest) Rules 1995 r4(a) , being US\$22.41 per day.
3. Further and/or alternatively, all necessary accounts and inquiries in respect of the Travellers Cheques issued by the Plaintiff.
4. Further and/or alternatively, an order that the Defendant do provide the Plaintiff with replacement banker's drafts for any drafts previously issued by the Defendant in respect of its liabilities arising out of the sale of Travellers Cheques herein.
5. All and any Declarations as to what sums are held on trust by the Defendant for the Plaintiff; alternatively are owed by the Defendant to the Plaintiff in respect of the above.
6. Fixed costs pursuant to Order 62 rule 1 of CI\$500.00 plus the fee on the issue of the writ of CI\$931.53 being a total of CI\$1,431.53; alternatively costs to be taxed.
7. Further and/or other relief.

If, within the time for returning the Acknowledgment of Service, the Defendant pays the total amount claimed of US\$110,896.71 and interests at the rate aforesaid calculated up to the date of payment, and fixed costs of CI\$1,431.53, further proceedings will be stayed. The money must be paid to the Plaintiff or it's Attorneys.
