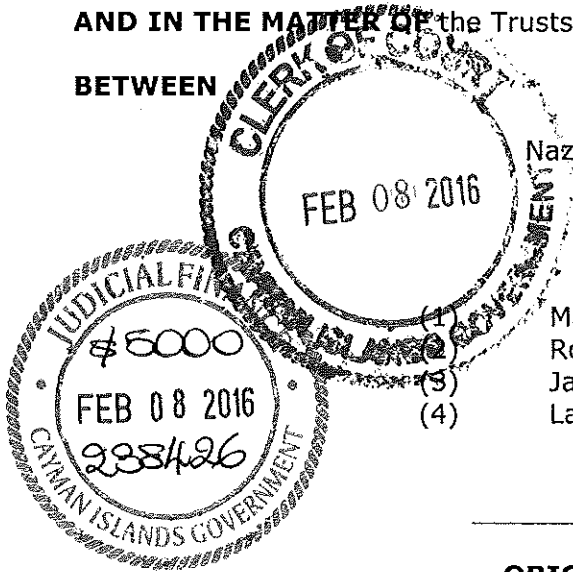

**ORIGINATING SUMMONS**

---

LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before the Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ 2016, at \_\_\_\_\_ am/pm.

By this Originating Summons, which is issued on the application of the Plaintiff, Nazeer International PTC of PO Box 1034, Harbour Place, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, 103 South Church Street, George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands, as trustee of the Iken Trust and other related trusts (the "Trusts"), against the Defendants (who are all beneficiaries of the Trusts), the Plaintiff seeks the determination of the Court to the following questions and the following orders and directions pursuant to GCR Order 85, Rule 2(2)(a):

1. Directions as to the extent of trust documents and information that the Plaintiff should disclose to any of the beneficiaries for the purpose of proceedings commenced in the Family Division of the High Court of Justice of England & Wales


(Application/Cause No: ZC15D03126) (or as it may be transferred or allocated) (the "Main Proceedings").

2. For an order confirming and approving the Plaintiff's decision (1) not to submit to the jurisdiction of the English Court in the Main Proceedings, and (2) not to agree to be joined as a party to the Main Proceedings if requested by any party to the Main Proceedings or ordered to do so by the English Court.
3. Further and in the alternative, for a direction as to (1) whether the Plaintiff should seek to be joined as a party to the Main Proceedings and (2) whether the Plaintiff should submit to the jurisdiction by participating in the Main Proceedings even if it has not been joined as a party.
4. An order that that the Plaintiff be permitted to apply for further directions in respect of its position in relation to the Main Proceedings if required to do so by developments in the Main Proceedings.
5. An order that the Plaintiff be permitted to, as it sees fit to (1) instruct English attorneys to act on its behalf on matters arising out of, and incidental to, the Main Proceedings; and (2) instruct and seek expert evidence from non-English attorneys (including but not limited to Cayman Islands attorneys) on matters arising out of, and incidental to, the Main Proceedings.
6. An order that the Plaintiff be indemnified against all and any costs and expenses arising out of, and incidental to, the Main Proceedings out of the assets of the Trust, including for the avoidance of doubt, its own professional charges in accordance with its terms and conditions as amended from time to time for the time of its own employees spent in dealing with the conduct of the Main Proceedings.
7. An order that the Plaintiff be at liberty to realise and/or raise funds from, wherever possible, the assets of the Trust for the purpose of settling the costs and expenses incurred by the Plaintiff arising out of, and incidental to, the Main Proceedings, as the Plaintiff thinks fit.
8. An order that a guardian ad litem be appointed to represent the interests of the 4<sup>th</sup> Defendant who is a minor.
9. All further and necessary orders and directions as this Court shall think fit, including,

if necessary, directions as to any necessary representation orders and service and/or notification of these proceedings.

10. That provision be made for the costs of this application.
11. That the parties be at liberty to apply for further or other relief.
