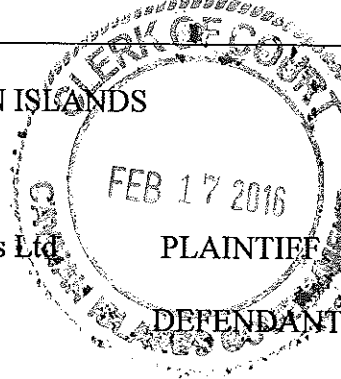
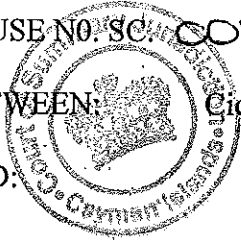

PLAINT


PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff is a motor vehicle rental company in Grand Cayman.
2. The Defendant resides in West Bay, Grand Cayman and is and was at all material times a customer of the plaintiff.
3. In or around May 2015, the defendant by way of an accident caused damages to one of the plaintiff's motor cars and agreed in writing that she was responsible for the accident as well as responsible for the damages to the said motor car, which damages amounted to CI\$1,890.06 .
4. The defendant has to date failed/refused to pay the damages despite several attempts on the part of the plaintiff to recover this sum.
5. The said sum of CI\$1,890.06 remains due and owing to the plaintiff.

And the plaintiff claims from the defendant:-

- a) Damages in the sum of CI\$81,890.06
- b) Costs in the sum of CI\$205.00
