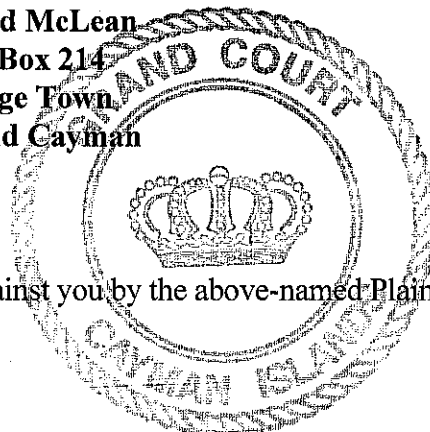

Within 14 days after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P. O. Box 495, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

NOTE : This Writ may not be served later than four calendar months beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

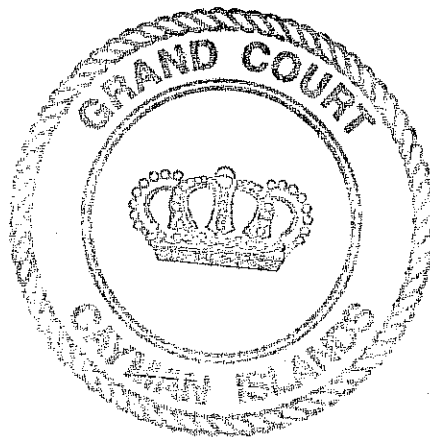
-IMPORTANT-

Directions for Acknowledgment of Service are given with the accompanying form.

If within the time for returning the acknowledgment of service, the Defendants pay the total sum claimed of CI\$4,850.00 together with fixed costs of CI\$500.00 and interest from 2nd July 1997 at the rate of CI\$0.98 per day until the date of payment, further proceedings will be stayed.

The money must be paid to the Plaintiff.

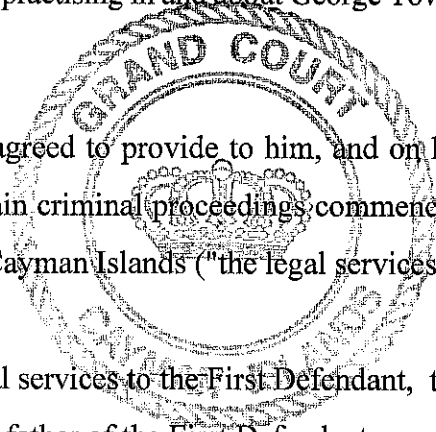

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

JUL -2 1997

1. The Plaintiff is and was at all material times a law firm practising in and about George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands.
2. At the request of the First Defendant, the Plaintiff agreed to provide to him, and on his behalf, professional legal services in relation to certain criminal proceedings commenced against the First Defendant in the Law Courts of the Cayman Islands ("the legal services").
3. In consideration of the Plaintiff providing the said legal services to the First Defendant, the First Defendant and the Second Defendant, who is the father of the First Defendant, agreed to be jointly and severally responsible to the Plaintiff for payment of the said legal services as provided by the Plaintiff to the First Defendant from time to time.
4. The said legal services were provided by the Plaintiff to the First Defendant between 27th November 1990 and 5th July 1991 whereupon on or about 8th July 1991 the Plaintiff rendered a final account to the said Defendants for an outstanding sum of CI\$4,850.00.
5. Despite demand, the Defendants have failed, refused and/or neglected to pay to the Plaintiff the said sum of CI\$4,850.00, such sum remaining due and payable to the Plaintiff by the Defendants.



6. The Plaintiff also claims interest upon the said sum of CI\$4,850.00 pursuant to the Judicature Law (1995 Revision) and the Judgment Debts (Rates of Interest) Rules 1996 at the prescribed rate of 7.3/8 % per annum or at such other rate as may be prescribed or as this Honourable Court deems just from the date of issuance of this proceeding.

Wherefore the Plaintiff claims:

1. Judgement against the First and Second Defendants in the sum of US\$4,850.00.
2. Pre-judgement interest on such judgment sum in accordance with section 34 of the Judicature Law (1995 Revision) at the rate of 7.3/8 % per annum pursuant to the Judgment Debts (Rates of Interest) Rules 1996 from 2nd July 1997 until payment being CI\$0.98 per day.
3. Post-judgement interest on such judgment sum in accordance with section 34 of the Judicature Law (1995 Revision) at the rate of 7 3/8 % per annum pursuant to the Judgement Debts (Rates of Interest) Rules 1996 from the date of judgment to the date of payment of the judgment sum being CI\$0.98 per day.
4. Such further or other relief.
5. Costs.
