If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

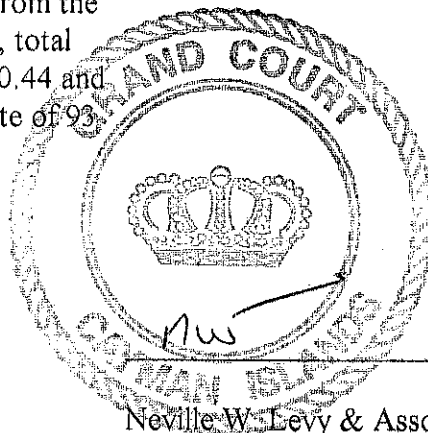
### SPECIAL ENDORSEMENT

1. The Plaintiff is an Attorney-at-Law.
2. Between the 30th June, 1993 and the 1st day of October, 1993, the plaintiff did legal work for the defendants valued at \$5,725.62 of which they paid \$1,100.00 leaving a balance of \$4,625.62 unpaid.
3. Several promises were made by the defendant's to pay, the last such promise having been made on the 15th March, 1996 but despite those promises, no money has been paid since the 19th day of July, 1993.
4. And the Plaintiff is entitled to interest on the said amount due pursuant to S. 34 of the Judicature Law (1995 Revision) at the Statutory Rate

#### **WHEREFORE THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS:-**

1. Balance of legal fees =\$4,625.62
2. Interest at the rate of 7 3/8 % p.a. from the 1st October, 1993 to 3rd July, 1997, total amount of interest claimed is \$1,280.44 and thereafter, interest accrues at the rate of 93 cents per day.
