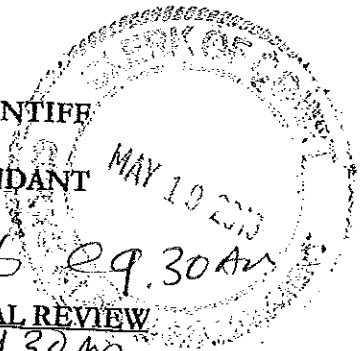
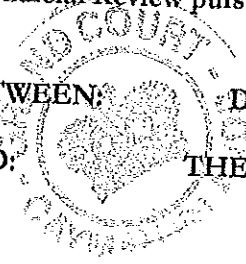

1. By its actions, the Defendant breached the Plaintiff's fundamental right against forced labour.
2. By its actions the Defendant breached the Plaintiff's fundamental right to family life. The Defendant took away the Plaintiff's remaining time in the Cayman Islands with his Spouse and family.
3. By its actions, the Defendant breached the Plaintiff's fundamental right of free movement within the Cayman Islands.
4. By its actions, the Defendant breached the Plaintiff's fundamental right against non-discrimination.
