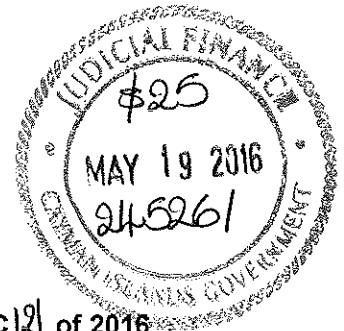

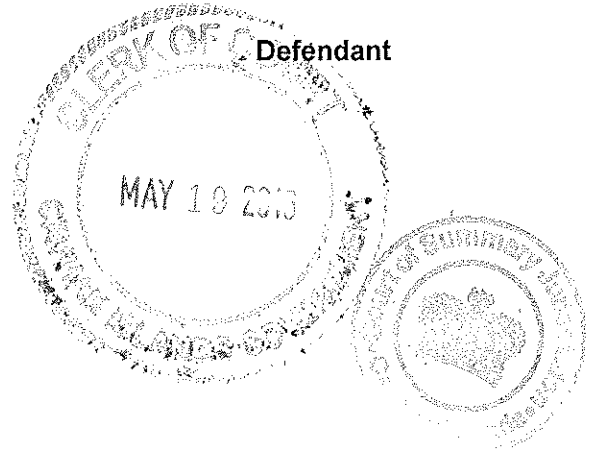


PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

(Here set out in numbered paragraphs, the grounds upon which the Plaintiff claims that the Defendant is indebted to him or is liable to pay damages to him).

1. The defendant caused a car accident on February 20th 2015 at approximately 8:30am.
2. The defendant drove into the plaintiff's vehicle at the Boilers Road Walkers Road junction. (Annex1)
3. Defendant was uninsured and had taken the vehicle without the owner's consent.
4. As a direct result of this accident plaintiff had to undertake repairs to her vehicle as well as hire a rental car to undertake daily duties.
5. Unannounced to the plaintiff or Officer Chong (investigating police officer), this matter was settled in the CI traffic court on 29.01.2016 (case #: 2015-005046) Annex 1.
6. In this matter the defendant plead guilty to 2 of 3 charges [charge (#04692/15): 1) careless driving and 2) driving without insurance], the 3rd (taking away a conveyance without the owner's consent) has been left on the defendant's file for 6 month.
7. The defendant was ordered to pay fines of \$260 for careless driving and \$400 for driving without insurance (total of \$660) to be paid by August 31st 2016.
8. No compensation was ordered to be paid for the damages to the plaintiff's vehicle.
9. Up to date the plaintiff has had no correspondence from the defendant with the plaintiff's compensation still outstanding.
10. As a direct result of the accident the plaintiff paid the garage E & S Paint & Body Shop \$2509.51 for necessary repair work (Annex 2: copy of garage invoice)
11. In addition, the plaintiff hired a car to perform her daily duties (Annex 3: copy of rental cost of \$347.50 Annex 3)
12. Attempts to negotiate payments for the damages with the defendant, both before and after sentencing, were fruitless or failed due to you not responding to several attempts (Annex 4).
13. A quote for repairs from a significantly more expensive garage is also attached to this document (Annex 5).
14. Specifically, on 31/03/2016 I attempted both phone calls and text messages to defendant and his mother, with no response!
15. In the text message, I stated, that I would proceed with small claims court if the defendant did not respond by April 15th 2016.

AND the Plaintiff claims:

1. The sum of \$2509.51 car repairs
2. The sum of 347.50 rental car
3. Fixed costs of \$150.00 + \$25.00 filing fee alternatively costs to be assessed.



Introduction

On Friday 20th February 2015 approximately 8:37am motor vehicle accident occurred along Boilers Road in the vicinity of Walkers Road.

The circumstances in this case are as follows

The evidence attached to file explained that the driver Mr D'Angelo Roper driver of a white Honda Crv registration 144-695 was driving along Boilers Road without due care and attention.

Accident Occurred

Vehicle #1 silver Toyota Rav-4 registration 114-364 driven by Ms Claudia Stich was travelling along Walkers Road towards George Town, Vehicle (2) white Honda Crv registration 144-695 driven by Mr D'Angelo Ropers was travelling along Boilers Road.

In the vicinity of Walkers Road Vehicle (2) Honda Crv approached the junction and failed to pay attention to the oncoming motorist whilst entering Walkers Road as a result Vehicle (1) Toyota Rav-4 that was travelling along Walkers Road towards George Town collided into the right front of Vehicle (2), from the impact both vehicles received minor and extensive damage.

Police Observation

Approximately 8:37am PC Chong receive radio transmission from 911 communication centre of a motor vehicle accident along Boilers Road in the vicinity of Walkers Road as a result PC Chong responded to the scene.

Approximately 8:42am PC Chong arrived at the scene and observed a silver Toyota Rav-4 Suv stationary along Walkers Road partially blocking the south bound lane facing in a southerly direction with right front end damage and the female driver standing next to the vehicle alert and conscious with no visible injury and declined medical treatment.

The second vehicle a white Honda Crv stationary along Boilers Road in the north bound lane partially blocking the roadway with front end damage, the male driver observed standing next to the vehicle alert and conscious with no visible injury and declined medical treatment

During my observation at the scene the area where both vehicles came to rest and the point of impact spray painted and photographed, shortly after both drivers were asked to remove their vehicles out of the roadway to allow safe passage to motorist.

PC Chong spoke with the female driver who identified herself as Ms Claudia Stich who gave a brief summary as to what occurred, she stated that whilst driving along Walkers Road a white Honda Crv pulled out onto the road and collided into her vehicle, after speaking to Ms Stich she was asked to attend George Town Police Station to provide a written statement re the motor vehicle accident

Driver of the second vehicle who identified himself as Mr D'Angelo Roper gave a brief summary as to what occurred, Ms Roper stated that he was travelling along Boilers Road heading to Medic Gas Station to get the vehicle wash.

In the vicinity of Walkers Road he stop and look both ways, on the left side there was a minibus stationary blocking his view but still take the chance and proceeded out on the main road, upon doing there was a vehicle travelling in the left lane collided into the front of his Honda Crv

During PC Chong conversation with Mr Roper subject was asked to provide the lodge book and Insurance for the vehicle, Upon inspecting the policy it showed that any driver over the age of 25yrs can drive the vehicle but unfortunate Mr Roper was only 17yrs old so therefore the Insurance policy doesn't covered him to drive the vehicle, attached to file is a copy of the Insurance policy as evidence.

CCTV Footage

During the Investigation the area checked for CCTV Camera but unfortunately result came back negative.

PC Chong concluded investigation at the scene of the accident and attended George Town Police Station, PC Chong spoke with Ms Claudia Stich and recorded a written statement as it relates to the motor vehicle accident, document attached to file as evidence.



In the vicinity of Walkers I came to a complete stop, I then look both side of the roadway, on the left side of the road there was a minibus stationary blocking my view as a result I then slowly creep out onto Walker Road as I about to enter the road I felt when a vehicle that was coming from the left lane travelling along Walkers Road collided into the right front of my Suv causing minor damage.





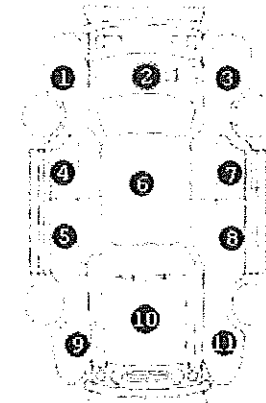
