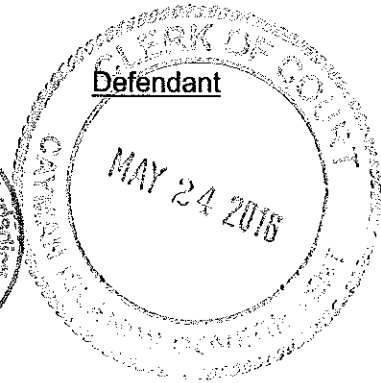
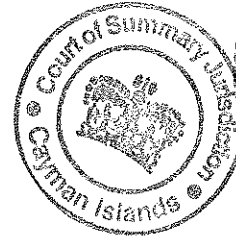

PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

1. Mr. Raymond Brown and his wife Mrs. Veronica Brown was issued a loan of CI\$1500 on the 6/10/2013. Mr Brown signed for the loan and the original due date was 21/11/2013.
2. Mr. Brown's first payment was made on the 10/12/2015 then on the 7/1/2015 he kept extending without payment, then the next payment he made was on the 31/8/2015, of only \$200.
3. The Browns have been very arrogant and uncivil whenever they are approached about this matter, I tried serving Miss. Brown a pre-summons notice and had her slam the door in my face and was very vocal about not knowing anything about the outstanding debt. The CIDCB has not been able to collect on the debt either.

- 1 The sum of \$3,340.00
- 2 Interest in the sum of \$3.48 calculated at the prescribed rate from 23/5/2014 to date.
- 3 Interest to continue until the matter is settled.
- 4 Fixed costs of \$ 150.00, alternatively costs to be assessed.
