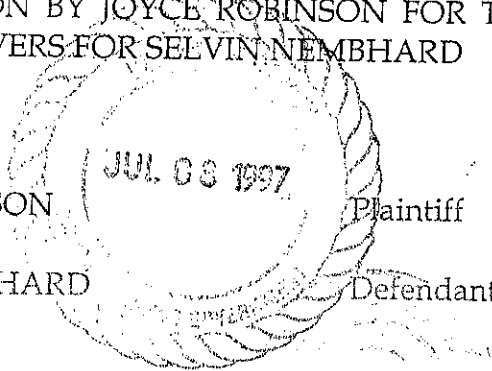

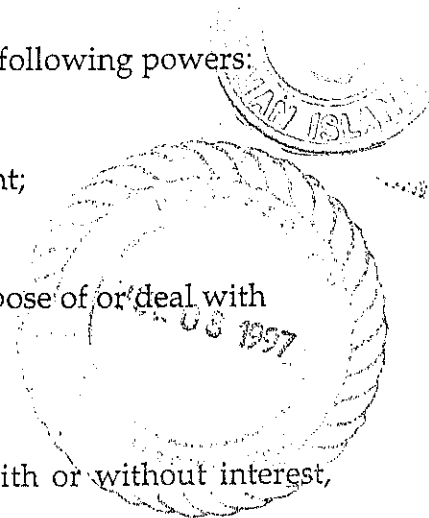


ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before the Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the 8th day of August, 1997 at 9:30 o'clock in the forenoon on the hearing of an application by Joyce Robinson for the following orders:

- (1) That Joyce Robinson and Kenneth Nembhard, the lawful children of the Defendant, be appointed guardians of the Defendant.

- (2) That the guardians whose appointment is sought have the duty, charge and custody of the defendant and the power to delegate such charge or custody to a competent and capable person.
- (3) That Joyce Robinson and Kenneth Nembhard also be appointed receivers for the defendant.
- (4) That the receivers whose appointment is sought have the following powers:
- (i) To call in and control any property of the Defendant;
 - (ii) To sell, acquire, exchange, charge or otherwise dispose of or deal with any property on behalf of the Defendant;
 - (iii) To reimburse out of the Defendant's property, with or without interest, any money applied by any person either in payment of the Defendant's debts (whether legally enforceable or not) or for the maintenance or benefit of the Defendant;
 - (iv) To institute, defend and conduct any legal proceedings brought by or on behalf of or against the Defendant;
 - (v) To enter into any settlement.
- (5) That the receivers need not deliver accounts to this Honourable Court.
- (6) That there be liberty to apply for further directions.



- (7) Such further or other relief as this Honourable Court shall deem appropriate.
- (8) That the costs of this application be paid from the property of the Defendant on an indemnity basis.
