ORIGINATING SUMMONS

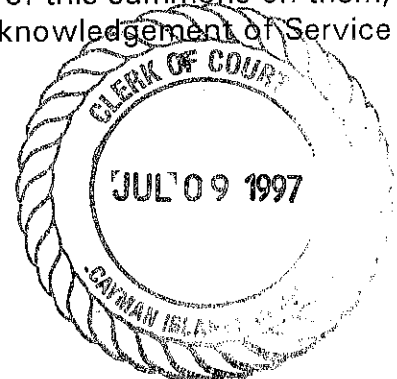
LET THE DEFENDANTS of P.O. Box 707, West Bay Road, Grand Cayman and c/o Ian Boxall & Co., P.O. Box 1234, George Town, Grand Cayman, respectively, attend before the Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of Aug 1997, at 9:30 o'clock on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiff P.O. Box 694, George Town, Grand Cayman and 8 Chemin de La Tour de Chempel, 1206 Geneva, Switzerland, respectively for the following orders:

- (1) a declaration that, pursuant to a deed of removal and appointment of trustees dated 26 June, 1997, the First Defendant has been replaced by the first plaintiff as trustees of a settlement dated 26 January, 1983 and made between Atef Danial of the one part and Roywest Trust Corporation (Cayman) Limited of the other part; and
- (2) an order that the First Defendant do within 14 days, transfer all the assets, documents and information of the said settlement to the First Plaintiff, and pending such transfer do hold the same upon trust for the First Plaintiff and deal with the same as directed by the First Plaintiff.

AND LET THE DEFENDANTS within 14 days after service of this summons on them, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service to the Court's office.
