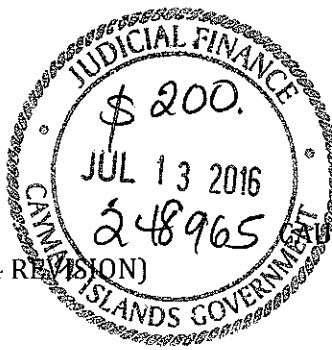

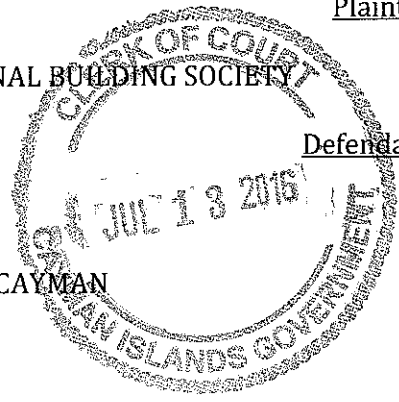
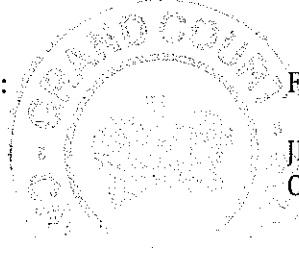

LET THE DEFENDANT, JN CAYMAN formerly, NATIONAL BUILDING SOCIETY OF CAYMAN attend before the Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the day of _____, 2016, at _____ am/pm, on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiff for an Order in the following terms:

1. That the sale on the property registered on the Cayman Islands land register as Registration Section Spotts, Block 25C Parcel 466 be stayed;
2. JN CAYMAN ("the Bank") shall not have vacant possession on 22nd July 2016 of the Property; and
3. The Bank shall provide an account statement immediately to the Plaintiff in respect of the Plaintiff's loan account dated 1st March 2010 to July 12th, 2016.

NOTES

Any person occupying the premises who is not named as a defendant by this summons may apply to the Court personally or by attorney to be joined as a defendant. If a person occupying the premises does not attend personally or by attorney at the time and place above-mentioned, such order will be made as the Court think just and expedient.

DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF SERVICE
OF ORIGINATING SUMMONS

The accompanying form of *Acknowledgment of Service* should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person. After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman

Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
3. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (*the name stated on the Originating Summons*)".
4. Where the Defendant is a **FIRM** and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a **PARTNER** by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
5. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual **TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN**, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is a **LIMITED COMPANY** the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on his behalf.
7. Where the Defendant is a **MINOR** or a **MENTAL PATIENT**, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a guardian *ad litem*.
8. A Defendant acting in person may obtain help in completing the form at the Courts Office.

Address for service:

Notes on address for service:

Attorneys: where the Defendant is represented by an attorney, state the attorney's place of business in the Cayman Islands. A Defendant may not act by a foreign attorney.

Defendant in person: where the Defendant is acting in person, he must give his post office box number and the physical address of his residence or, if he does not reside in the Cayman Islands, he must give an address in Grand Cayman where communications for him should be sent. In the case of a limited company, "residence" means its registered principal office.
