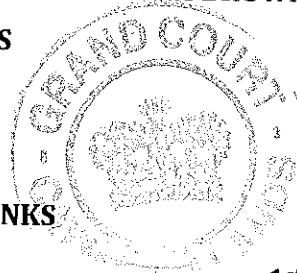

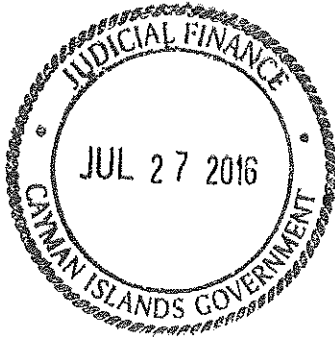

EXPARTE ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET ALL PARTIES attend before a Judge in chambers at the Grand Court at the law Court  
in George Town, Grand Cayman on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2016 at  
9.30 AM o'clock in the fore/afternoon on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiff  
for an Order that:

1. The 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Plaintiffs be appointed joint Guardians for the Respondent  
("Patient") pursuant to section 14. GCL (2015 Revision) and over her estate and  
effects with the following power conferred upon them:
  - (a) To control and manage any property of the Patient;

- (b) To sell, acquire, charge or otherwise dispose of or deal with any real property of the Patient;
  - (c) To invest the proceeds of sale or any other monies belonging to the Patient in such securities as the Applicant for the time being is authorized by law to invest trust funds.
  - (d) To deposit into and withdraw from any account at any bank or lending Institution in the Cayman Islands and elsewhere such of the Patient's monies as may be necessary for the proper maintenance and care of the Patient.
  - (e) To make decisions concerning medical care of the including with respect to approving any medical examinations, procedures or operations to be carried out on the Patient.
2. That the Petitioner shall keep proper accounts of the administration and management of the property of the Patient and whenever required by the Court to do so shall file in Court copies of such accounts.
  3. That the cost of this application and cost of the guardian incidental to and consequent upon the Order shall be paid from the estate and property of the Patient if any.
  4. Any other such Order as this Honorable Court sees fit.
