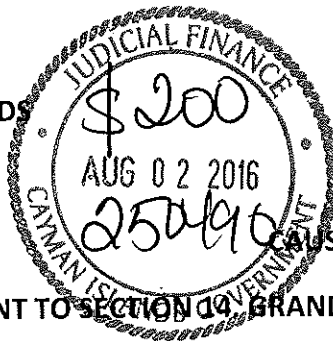

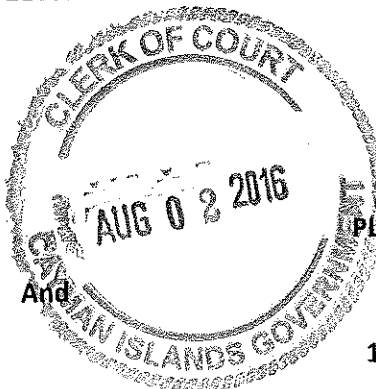

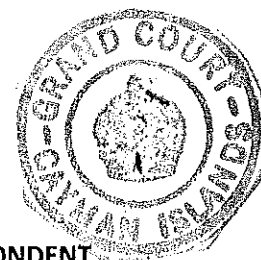

ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET ALL PARTIES attend before a Judge in chambers at the Grand Court at the law Court in George Town, Grand Cayman on the _____ day of _____, 2016 at _____ o'clock in the fore/afternoon on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiff for an Order or orders as the court may deem appropriate that:

1. The Plaintiff be appointed Guardians for Respondent ELVIS DARON RIVERS AND RESPONDENT MARIS LEXTON RIVERS (each a "Patient" and together the "Patients") pursuant to section 14. GCL (2015 Revision) and over their estate and effects with the following power conferred upon her:
 - (a) To control and manage any property of each Patient;
 - (b) To sell, acquire, charge or otherwise dispose of or deal with any real property of each Patient;

- (c) To invest the proceeds of sale or any other monies belonging to each Patient in such securities as the Applicant is authorized by law to invest trust funds.
 - (d) To deposit into and withdraw from any account at any bank or lending Institution in the Cayman Islands and elsewhere of each Patient such of the Patient's money as may be necessary for the proper maintenance and care of My brothers or either of them.
 - (e) To make decisions concerning medical care of each Patient including with respect to approving any medical examinations, procedures or operations to be carried out on or for each Patient.
2. That the Petitioner shall keep proper accounts of the administration and management of the property of each Patient and whenever required by the Court to do so shall file in Court copies of such accounts.
 3. Any other such Order as this Honorable Court sees fit.
