If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

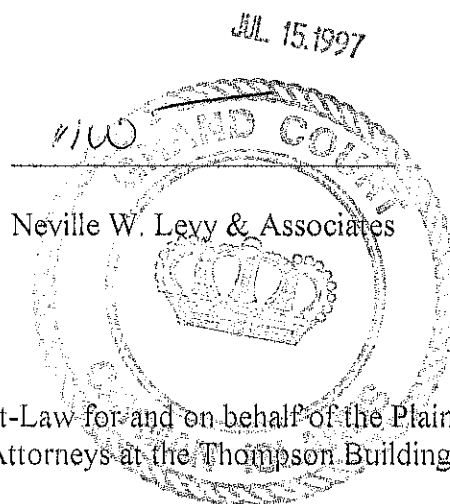
Special Endorsement

1. The Plaintiff is a local Company licensed to drill wells and supply plumbing materials.
2. The defendant is a businessman and land developer.
3. On or about the 16th day of May, 1995 the plaintiff dug wells for the defendant resulting in a debt of \$2,604.18 which he promised to pay to the plaintiff but has failed to pay despite several demands.
4. And the Plaintiff is entitled to Interest on the said amount due pursuant to S.34 of the Judicature Law (1995 Revision)

WHEREFORE THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS:-

1. The amount due =\$2,604.18
2. Interest from the 16th day of May, 1995 until payment at statutory rate pursuant to S. 34 of the Judicature Law (1995 Revision).
3. Costs to be taxed or agreed.
