

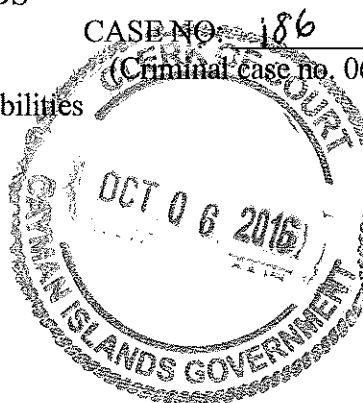
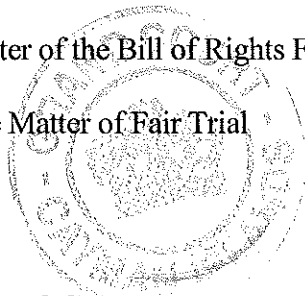

PETITION

**To the Grand Court**

The humble petition of Tanjala Mihai, currently held in Northward Prison, Cayman Islands, shows that:-

1. The Cayman Islands government has breached and infringed the Petitioner's rights and freedoms, under the Bill of Rights, Freedoms and Responsibilities, prevailed in Constitution of Cayman Islands, section 26.

Your Petitioner(s) therefore humbly pray(s) that:-

1. This Petition under Section 26 of the Bill of Rights is submitted for relief following a breach of the Petitioner's rights and freedoms under the said Bill of Rights.

[2.] Such orders as the Court thinks fit.

[3.] In particular, the Petitioner's right to a fair and public hearing by an independent and impartial court, pursuant to Section 7 of the Bill of Rights, was breached. As a consequence of this breach, Section 5 of the Bill of Rights was also breached by the government unlawfully depriving the Petitioner of his liberty and freedom. The Petitioner is seeking his immediate release and compensation to be paid under Section 5(6) of the Bill of Rights.
